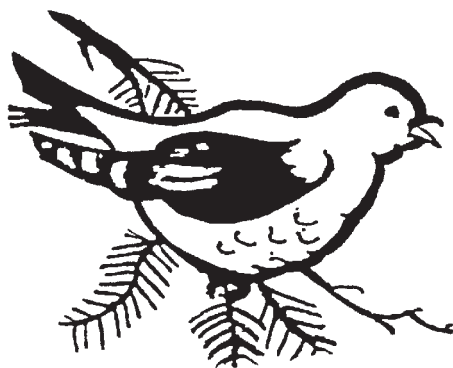

Northwest Minnesota Foundation awards grant to North Country Community Health Services

Bonnie Engen of the North Country Community Health Services Board, Robin Larson, Project Coordinator for The Idea Circle in Bagley, Tom Anderson of Clearbrook, Vice Chair of the Northwest Minnesota Foundation, and Nate Dorr, who is the Northwest Minnesota Foundation program officer for grants met in front of the Clearwater County Courthouse last Tuesday.

They gathered to discuss the purpose of a \$25,000 grant Northwest Minnesota Foundation (NMF) gave to North Country Community Health Services (NCCHS), whose Board is the governing body for public health providers serving Beltrami, Clearwater, Hubbard and Lake of the Woods counties.

Enthusiasm was evident in the conversation as they explained what this grant means to the local communities for helping youth deal with mental health and trauma issues, and the inter-connection to physical well-being of individuals. Their goal is to see youth learn ways for healthy coping and grieving

during stressful times in their lives, they explained.

They said this grant will help them to assist in the school systems for youth who have been affected by such adverse childhood experiences (ACES) as death or divorce, abuses, or multiple moves which can be extremely stressful. If the schools can identify issues early in life it can help the children to deal with the difficulties they are facing with more positive skills.

Another use of the grant money is for new mothers learning to care for and bond with their babies.

"Among the mental health professionals there are many pockets of specialty. The providers don't always know what's available," Bonnie Engen said. With this program there can be more prevention taking place.

People who are under a great deal of stress often develop unhealthy coping skills which leads to greater problems for them later in life, such as alcoholism or drug abuse. Nate Dorr calls this "toxic stress".

Robin Larson, The Idea Circle Project Coordinator in

Bagley, pointed out that on a national scale most programs are limited to communities with 150,000 people or more. The four counties that this grant will assist comprise of around 80,000 people. The Idea Circle will be hired as a consultant to help NCCHS with use of the grant.

"This project seeks to improve the region's capacity in public health with strategies in promotion, prevention, crisis management and client advocacy," said Bonnie Engen, NCCHS administrator. "NMF's grant dollars will be used to expand and define partner roles and responsibilities, conduct strategic planning and build systems to increase efficiency."

"Achieving better health outcomes in our communities requires a coordinated effort among public leaders and healthcare systems," Mr. Dorr said.

He said the Community Connection in Bemidji program is supported by the McKnight Foundation. Their philosophy is to let the locals run the local programs.

Spring is Year-Around at Extended Seasons in Bagley

As a novice gardener but a dedicated foodie, I was intrigued by the new store in Bagley called "Extended Seasons Indoor Gardening". Entering the store, you are greeted by owner, Dan Swanson. Dan is originally from Mankato, where he met his wife Cherish (Hagen), originally from Clearbrook. She is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Gordy Hagen of Clearbrook.

When Cherish accepted a position at BSU, it was the perfect opportunity for Dan to open the store that caters to his passion: high quality food production, with no weeding!

A friend sparked his interest in hydroponic container gardening about five years ago.

With the intense focus now on healthy, clean eating and obtaining foods that contribute to our health, Extended Seasons is an exciting new addition to our communities.

Can you imagine going to your living room and snipping fresh lettuce, peppers and herbs for a salad in January? Or how about kale for your smoothie in February? This is something I am definitely ready to try!

The store focuses on home hydroponic gardening. In the hydroponic garden, plants are started and grown with no soil (and no weeds!) and are maintained with a timed pump that bathes the roots in nutrient rich water. Dan starts with reverse osmosis water and adds nutrients so he is able to have better control over what the plant receives.

Dan has different displays to look at in his store that are in the growing stages for produce such as brussel sprouts, all kinds of peppers and lettuces, kale, herbs, melons, peas and more! Hydroponic gardening, even though you are using water, uses 70-90% less water than traditional gardening. If you are using this method indoors, you basically need to control the season with lighting, and with LED lighting this is becoming more cost effective all the time. It is easy to adapt to your space limitations as well, even using a shelf in a bookcase!

Hydroponically grown plants actually grow faster, since the nutrient is supplied directly to the plant ready to use, instead of having to extract those nutrients from the soil. You can also do hydro-

ponic container gardening outdoors in the summer. (Still no weeding!)

Dan has designed and sells different kinds of set ups to begin your own hydroponic gardening system, and even has classes to help get you up to speed. Classes are held twice monthly for \$10 or \$15 per couple. You can register online for classes at www.extendedseasons.com, and of course, check him out on Facebook. Classes can also be arranged for interested groups.

Dan additionally sells many items for traditional gardening, such as bat guano and worm casings. These are natural ways to add nutrients back into our soil, which is depleted every year through traditional gardening. These nutrients are free of weed seeds and won't

Northwest Minnesota Foundation celebrates donors making a difference

The Northwest Minnesota Foundation (NMF) Board of Directors and staff recently hosted a Donor Appreciation Dinner to recognize individuals and organizations who have made significant contributions to the Foundation's endowment or charitable funds that it manages.

At the Hampton Inn in Bemidji, more than 100 people gathered on March 26th to celebrate the philanthropic spirit in Northwest Minnesota. Seven new Circle of Vision donors, who have each made gifts of over \$100,000, received awards.

They are Jess and Wanda Dishman, born in Oklee, who established a scholarship fund for Red Lake County schools; Sam and Jane Evans, Roseau, who established a Donor-Advised fund; the Mike and Sarah Karvakkko family, Laporte, who are also building a Donor-Advised fund; the Mississippi Headwaters Blood Bank, Bemidji, which recently disbanded and began a scholarship fund for area students entering Clinical Laboratory Science along with an Interactive Blood Display project fund for Bemidji's Headwaters Science Center, and; Bob Naylor, Bemidji, who has a Donor-Advised fund with NMF.

Also included posthumously were John and Faye Hedin, Fosston and Gonvick, who set up a bequest to fund scholarships in their home towns, and Russell and Eleanor Jeske of Mahanomen, who with a bequest

are supporting the economic development of the Twin Valley area through a community fund at NMF.

Upon accepting the Circle of Vision award, Jane Evans said, "Our belief is that giving is important, whether it is our time or money. We are grateful to God that we have been able to make a significant gift. We thank Northwest Minnesota Foundation for their guidance in setting up our donor advised fund to create this legacy. It will allow our children to also experience the joy of financial giving."

A new giving level was initiated this year for donors whose lifetime giving has reached or exceeded \$500,000. Two couples were recognized as Circle of Vision Community Champions: Mark and Peg Hewitt of Park Rapids and Peggy and Sam Johnson of Warroad. They have contributed to Donor-Advised Funds, other component funds housed with NMF, and generously supported NMF's general endowment.

"It is an honor to recognize these individuals," said NMF Board Chair Pete Haddeland. "It is truly amazing how their generosity is impacting the region in which we live – they are all great community partners and we appreciate their willingness to give back!"

Father Manny Sundaram to celebrate 25 Years of Priesthood

On Sunday, May 3 Fr. Manny Sundaram, pastor of St. Joseph's in Bagley and St. Mary's in Fosston will be honored at a celebration in recognition of his Silver Jubilee, twenty-five years as a priest in the Roman Catholic Church. The festivities will begin at St. Mary's in Fosston with a 5 o'clock Mass. Special guests will include Bishop Hoeppner from the Diocese of Crookston and priests and deacons of the diocese.

Jim Martin from St. Joseph's will emcee a short program after Mass, and dinner will follow in the Fellowship Hall.

Father Manual "Manny" Sundaram was born in Padregudi in southeast India where he went to school with his seven siblings, four brothers and three sisters. His father was a Middle School Principal while his mother, now deceased, worked as the Head of the Postal Department in his home town. He attended a boarding school to further his education.

In college he earned a Master's degree of Divinity in 'World Religions' and was ordained into the priesthood on September 30, 1990 in India by Bishop Edward Francis.

In 2001, Fr. Manny came to the United States to study at Loyola University in Baltimore, Maryland, where he completed

a Master Degree in counseling psychology. He served in hospitals and nursing homes as a chaplain and also did pastoral counseling for eight years until 2009.

From 2009 to 2010, as part of his mission work, he served as pastor of the Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Roseau, Minnesota. He then went to Orange County, California for three years to help his sister, a nurse, get established at a hospital. While there he again worked as a chaplain.

After studies to become a United States citizen Fr. Manny received his citizenship papers in August of 2012.

In 2013 Bishop Hoeppner assigned Fr. Manny to serve the parishes of St. Mary's in Fosston and St. Joseph's in Bagley.

Greg Cook Logging Named Minnesota SFI Logger of the Year

The Minnesota Sustainable Forestry Initiative(r) Implementation Committee (SIC) named Greg Cook Logging as the 2015 Logger of the Year. The award was given by Roger Johnson, SIC chair and forester with Molpus Timberlands on April 14, during the Minnesota Logger Education Program Conference held in Tower, Minnesota.

Being selected to receive the Logger of the Year Award in Minnesota may occur only once. However, operating as the Logger of the Year is a full-time job and a lifetime commitment. Greg Cook Logging has accomplished both.

"Greg Cook Logging exemplifies the significant and unique contribution the state's timber harvesters provide Minnesota's economy, wildlife and healthy forests" said Tim O'Hara, coordinator of the Duluth-based Minnesota SIC and vice president of forest policy with Minnesota Forest Industries.

Greg Cook started the logging business in the 1970s in the Bigfork area. In 2006, his son, Clinton, purchased the business from his father. Minnesota's woods and timber harvesting were not unfamiliar ground to Clinton; he had worked alongside his dad since he was in the eighth grade.

The company has grown with Clinton; both the company and Clinton are known for being hard-working, honest, and motivated to continually improve. Clinton is the first to admit that behind a great logging company is an outstanding crew. His wife, Tracy, manages the office operations along with forester Carl Bleiler and the company's long-time equipment operators: Jason Roach, Fred Pitzen, and Jason Tower to name just a few.

"The Minnesota SFI Logger of the Year Award should be defined by the characteristics of honesty, hard-work and motivation to continually improve," Damon Polus, Procurement Forester with Sappi Fine Paper wrote on his nomination form. "Greg Cook Logging fits that definition perfectly."

The company's professionalism does not begin and end in the woods. Greg Cook Logging has been a member of the Minnesota Logger Education

Program since the program's beginnings in 1997. Showing its commitment to safety and high standards, 25 to 30 of the company's employees annually attend training both to ensure safety on the job and high-quality woods work. The company has achieved recognition as Minnesota Master Loggers since 1996.

Nominations for the 2015 honor came from not only the logging community, but from private landowners and professional consulting foresters, proving that Greg Cook Logging has conducted its operations "over and above" the expectations and standards of peers in the profession. A Zim, Minnesota private landowner lauded the company on its sensitivity to the recreational goals he had for his woodland.

Minnesota Consulting Forester Steven Ludwig noted Greg Cook Logging's special acknowledgment of potential erosion issues and the aesthetics of the harvest areas he works in. Ludwig also noted the company's special attention to the myriad of markets available for the variety of forest products harvested from a private woodland located south of Akeley, including soft- and hardwood sawmills, pallet and paper mills, posts, and firewood. Over 10 different locations received wood from the harvest.

Greg Cook Logging's commitment to sustainable forestry and high ethics does not end in the woods. Clinton has served on the board of directors of the Minnesota Timber Producers Association, as well as on its Transportation and Membership committees.

"Greg Cook Logging represents perfectly the commitment to responsible forestry that is required to achieve logger of the year. The team's significant contributions to a sustainable community, conservation, logger training and market access are what make them leaders," said Kathy Abusow, SFI President and CEO of SFI Inc.

The Minnesota SIC includes representatives from the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources, forest companies, the University of Minnesota, family forest owners, the Minnesota Logger Education Program, Minnesota Timber Producers Association, Minnesota Tree Farm Program, the National Wild Turkey Federation, and county land departments certified to the SFI Standard.

Warrant executed on Meth Lab in Bagley

On April 16, 2015 a search warrant was executed at 924 Patricia Lane, Bagley. A "Meth Lab" was located on the premises. Four arrests followed.

The investigation was a result of the combined efforts of the Bagley Police Department, Paul Bunyan Drug Task Force and the Clearwater County Sheriff's Office.

Those arrested include Andre Chevalier, Darrin Forsberg, Tamara Laws and Gabrielle Poitra, all occupants of the Patricia Lane address.

Each of the defendants appeared in District Court on Friday having been charged with Controlled substance in the First degree, a felony carrying a maximum sentence of 40 years in prison, a \$1,000,000 fine, or both; Possession of a substance with intent to manufacture Methamphetamine, a felony carrying a maximum sentence of 15 years in prison, a \$30,000 fine, or both, and Methamphetamine related crimes involving children, a felony carrying a maximum sentence of 5 years in prison, a \$10,000 fine or both.

All defendants are scheduled to make their next appearance in the District Court on April 22, 2015.

Also helping were the Bagley Fire Department, Clearwater Department of Human Services, Sanford Ambulance and Hospital.

Want to go fishing? DNR has a license to fit

A lone angler casts a lure into a glassy lake on a warm spring day, surrounded by the sounds of nature. What's missing? A friend or family member could be sharing the scene.

"If you know someone who might be interested, ask them to go fishing. Many people won't fish unless someone asks them to go," said Jenifer Wical, of the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources outreach section. "Before heading out, make sure to buy your fishing licenses."

Buy licenses at any DNR license agent, online with a mobile or desktop device at www.mndnr.gov/buyalicense, or by phone at 888-665-4236. Mobile buyers receive a text or email that serves as proof of a valid fish or game license to state conservation officers. An adult individual angling license is \$22.

"There are types of fishing licenses to fit most anyone's needs. There are licenses for married couples, for individual adults, and for 24-hour, 72-hour, and three-year time periods," Wical said. "Lifetime licenses can make it easier for people to keep fishing long into the future, and licenses also come at reduced cost for children and those ages 51 and older."

Youth ages 16 and 17 can buy an annual license for \$5. Kids 15 and under are not required to buy a license to fish, but must comply with fishing regulations.
