A group of about 80 people gathered at the Dan & Darlene Dierkes (formerly Morris & Alpha Johnson) farm near McIntosh on the morning of Saturday, July 4th. Over doughnuts, bars and coffee, they were transformed into the Continental Congress, and listened while their fellow Congressman, Thomas Jefferson, read the final draft of the Declaration of Independence. The list of grievances against King George the III was very shocking for anyone who wasn't aware of how the colonists had been mistreated under his tyrannical rule!

Fifty-six members of the group had each been given a card with the information of one of the original signers. One by one, they each declared aloud that they were signing this historical document by stating their name, occupation and home state. After the verbal signing, the crowd applauded this country's newfound freedom and sang "God Bless America," led by Thomas

Jefferson (also known as Pastor Karl Anderson).
Patriotism is important to the Dierkeses, and they hosted this event to help remind people of the history and significance of the Independence Day holiday. But just as importantly, they wanted a chance for friends and neighbors to gather together and visit.
Darlene explained that this was not an original idea; in her job as an insurance agent at North Risk Partners' St. Cloud Apollo office, she has customers who have made this a tradition for 30 years. "I have always loved what they do, and wanted to try it here, where community is already so important."
They are grateful for the help of neighbors, friends and family for the successful inaugural event, and to everyone who came. Partial detour of Highway 89 near Bemidji begins July 6

Detour required as part of the Highway 2 and Highway 89 intersection reconstruction project

BEMIDJI, Minn. – Motorists traveling through the Highway 2 and Highway 89 intersection near Bemidji will encounter a partial detour on Highway 89 beginning Monday, July 6 as the Highway 2 median is closed to traffic.

The partial detour includes all southbound Highway 89 traffic and eastbound Highway 2 motorists intending to drive north on Highway 89. Those motorists will be detoured on Beltrami County Road 515/ Scribner Road NW. The detour will remain through the duration of the project, which is expected to be complete in October, weather permitting.

The detour will not affect motorists on westbound Highway 2 until the full closure of Highway 89, which is expected to take place in mid-august.

Highway 2 is currently reduced to single lane traffic in both the eastbound and westbound lanes and a two-day detour is planned prior to the

Highway 89 closure in mid-august to allow for the setting of bridge beams.

Residents and business owners are encouraged to attend an open house Thursday, July 9 to get an update on the project and have questions answered directly from contractor representatives, MnDOT staff and other project officials.

The informal open house begins at 6 p.m. in room 151 at the Bemidji MnDOT building, 3920 Highway 2 West.

The intersection reconstruction project will result in a safer intersection with improved turning lanes, intersection lighting, and an overpass for motorists on Highway 89 to access the eastbound lanes of Highway 2.

“From Palms to Pines—The Jefferson Highway in Minnesota” Ren Holland speaker, with special guest Frank Mitchell July 18, 2015, 10 AM, Lund Lutheran Church, Gully, Minnesota Recently there has been a renewed interest in the Jefferson Highway, an early automobile route that linked small towns from New Orleans, Louisiana, to Winnipeg, Manitoba. One of the reasons for the interest is that 2015 marks 100 years since the highway was conceived. This auto trail must have stirred much local interest in 1916 when towns like Bagley, Gonvick, and Gully were selected as points on the map for the nation’s first international highway.

After much initial celebration and publicity, the Jefferson Highway quietly disappeared from maps in the 1920s. What caused this to happen? Are there traces of it today? These and other questions will be answered at a special program during Gully Day on July 18. Ren Holland and Frank Mitchell have been spreading the word about this interesting route. Both men were raised near Itasca Park and lived on the Jefferson for years without knowing much about it until recently. Local communities are now becoming excited about searching for evidence of the original route, which often can be found in today's trails around swamps and hills, and through pastures.

Ren became interested in the route while writing *The Edge of Itasca* and *The Early Resorts of Minnesota*, both books about Minnesota's history. His website contains many resort photos, maps, and a blog on early tourism.

Frank has lived all of his life along the old Jefferson route on a farm homesteaded by his father, and he shares a unique family heritage. He is the historian for the Hubbard County Historical Society and is an active member of the Jefferson Highway Association. The Jefferson Highway had a significant impact on early tourism, as well as laying the groundwork for some of today's major highways. We hope you will join Ren and Frank on July 18 to learn more about this area's history.

Ren was born in Park Rapids, Minnesota. His parents owned a small resort on Little Mantrap Lake. He attended a rural school and graduated from Park Rapids High School. He received a Bachelor of Arts degree in art and a Bachelor of Science degree in education at the University of Minnesota, and a Master of Science degree in education from St. Cloud State University.

After retiring from teaching high school at Little Falls, he pursued a new interest in writing with *The Edge of Itasca* (2004) and *The Early Resorts of Minnesota* (2012). He continues his interest in history with slide programs, and writes historical articles for his website at renholland.com/ Ren lives in Little Falls, Minnesota with his wife, Ida Mae. 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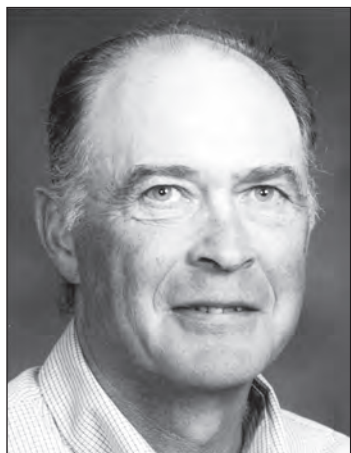

He is preceded in death by his parents; and sister, Dorothy.

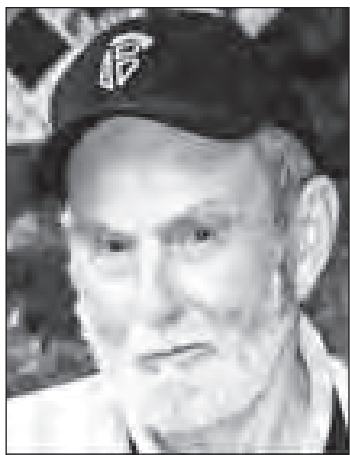

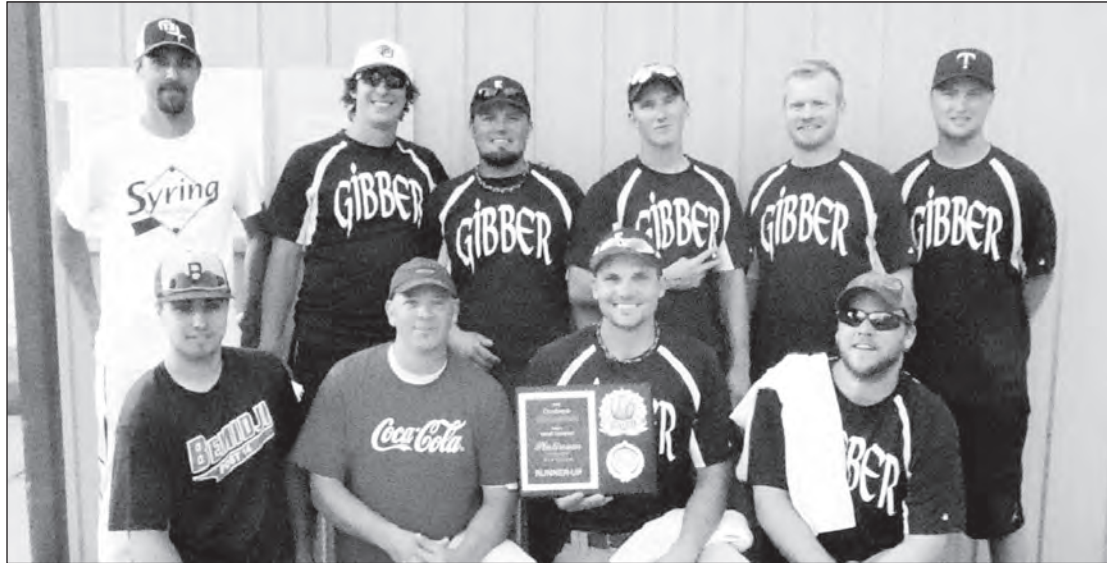

Wildlife Drive opening July 18 at Roseau River Wildlife Management Area

The 27-mile "Wildlife Drive" through the Roseau River Wildlife Management Area (WMA), 20 miles northwest of Roseau, will be open to vehicular travel July 18-26 and the following weekends through Aug. 16. The drive traverses wetland, woodland, brushland and farmland habitats, providing visitors ample opportunity to see wildlife.

Roseau River WMA is one of the viewing stops along the Pine to Prairie Birding Trail, which consists of 45 sites spanning a 223-mile corridor from pine to prairie in the northwestern part of the state. These sites offer some of the most spectacular birding in the state, along with scenic beauty and friendly communities.

The viewing route also cuts through the northern reaches of the Juneberry 3 wildfire, which burned an area in excess of 30,000 acres in October 2011. The fire opened up stands of woody vegetation, creating new foraging sites for birds and mam-

mals and improving nesting cover for a wide array of birds for years to come.

Approximately 149 bird species breed within the Roseau River WMA. Yellow rails, horned grebes and Western grebes are a few of the rare breeding species found within the area's vast wetlands. Along the drive you may also encounter trumpeter swans, loons, white pelicans, sandhill cranes, great blue herons, eagles, a variety of ducks and other water birds, sedge wrens, yellow warblers, Nelson's sharp-tailed sparrows, black bears, deer, beaver, otter, muskrat, red fox, gray wolf and the occasional moose.

Aside from excellent wildlife viewing opportunities, the WMA "pools" offer spectacular year-round northern pike fishing opportunities. Visitors typically fish along the dike roads or near the water control structures. When the dike roads are closed to motorists, visitors can bike to Pool 1 West or Pool 2 from the parking areas. During the

waterfowl hunting season only, motorboats of 10 horsepower or less may be used on the Roseau River WMA.

The Wildlife Drive can be easily accessed at the main dike road, located one and three-quarter miles south of the WMA headquarters on Roseau County Road 3. Only motor vehicles licensed for use on public highways are legally permitted to operate on this road. Motorists are urged to use caution due to narrow roads, soft shoulders, deep ditches and two-way traffic. The speed limit on all WMA roads is 20 mph. Note that the wildlife drive may be closed due to inclement weather or road construction.
