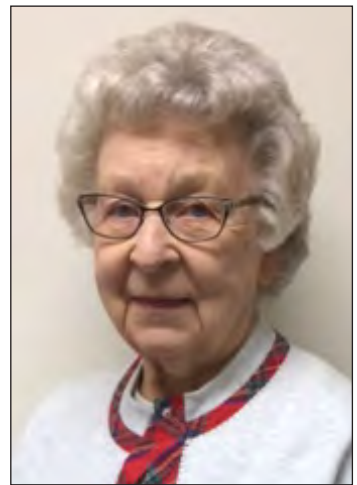
Answer: "It gives me the ability to help and to serve. It's like giving Widman's Candy away."

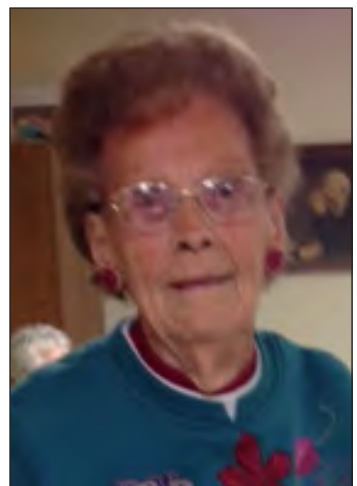

Two Fosston Elementary children saved by booster seats

BEMIDJI, Minn. – To kick off the statewide Click it or Ticket extra seat belt enforcement campaign, the Minnesota State Patrol, Polk County Public Health, Polk County Sheriff's Office, Polk County Toward Zero Deaths Coalition and Northwest Minnesota Toward Zero Deaths partners held an assembly with more than 300 Fosston Elementary School students to honor two classmates for being "Saved by the Belt."

Emilee and Jakob Rudie recently survived a crash, where their vehicle rolled several times. Before the crash ever took place, Angie Rudie made sure her children were properly restrained in their booster seats.

"It can happen in a second. If they were not buckled, they may not be here today," said Angie Rudie, Jakob and Emilee's mom. "I had marks on my neck from my seatbelt. We rolled probably six times.

It was probably a second after we landed when I had to turn around and check on my kids it was the longest second of my life. And they were ok. Nothing mattered after that."

Extra Enforcement Now on Minnesota Roads

To continue enforcing the law and reminding motorists that seat belts save lives, law enforcement across northeast Minnesota will join more than 300 law enforcement agencies across the state participating in

the Click It or Ticket campaign now through June 4. The extra enforcement and education campaign is coordinated by the Department of Public Safety Office of Traffic Safety.

Parents should not start the engine until everyone in the vehicle is properly belted.

"Jakob is 8 and I still make sure he rides in a booster seat. Emilee is small for her age and is still in a five-point harness," according to Rudie. "When we were in the crash, Emilee didn't move. Her booster seat stayed in the same place. When we landed, Emilee said, Mom, go get my shoe. I asked, Where is your shoe? When we started rolling, it flew out the window, Emilee said. All I could think about was, it could have been Emilee."

"Please wear your seatbelt - and make sure your children ride in booster seats, car seats and seatbelts - because you are very important to a lot of people who love you," Rudie said.

The Good News and Bad News
Fortunately, most Minnesotans are making the life-saving decision to buckle up.

"In 2016, preliminary numbers show 79 unbelted motorists lost their lives on Minnesota roads.

"Since TZD's inception in 2003, traffic-related deaths have declined by 40 percent. More than half of all deaths occurring on Minnesota roads occur on rural roads. Unbelted crashes continue to be higher in rural areas.

The Northwest Minnesota Toward Zero Deaths program brings area law enforcement, public health educators, engineers and emergency medical and trauma services together to reduce the number of traffic fatalities and severe injuries to zero in northeast Minnesota. The 11-county area encompasses: Beltrami, Clearwater, Hubbard, Kittson, Lake of the Woods, Polk, Pennington, Marshall, Norman, Red Lake and Roseau.

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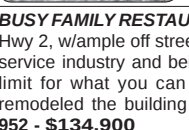
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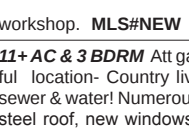

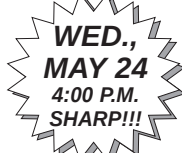

Ask a Trooper
by Sgt. Jesse Grabow Minnesota State Patrol



Question: I was told that the Minnesota State Patrol is involved in teaching a school patrol camp in the summer. Can you provide me with some information about it?

Answer: Legionville is a summer camp is where school patrol students are taught the fundamentals of school patrol, school bus safety, bicycle and pedestrian safety. It is located just north of Brainerd, and it operated by the American Legion, using State Patrol Troopers as instructors. I will be one of the instructors again this year.

Students who will be 10 years old before September 1st and not older than 13 years will be accepted. Exceptions to this restriction can be made but must be cleared in advance through the American Legion. Legionville is currently taking applications.

Legionville will be celebrat-



ing 79 years of instruction. It actually started 81 years ago in 1936, but because of World War II, class was canceled in 1942 & 1943. The 'old familiar barn' is gone and a new one has been built.

Besides school patrol and school bus patrol training by troopers, other instructors help complete the week with swimming, canoeing, first aid training and many other activities and games. The camp is a very active place. Parents can pay for their kids to go, even though there may be some limited numbers of scholarships available each year through local schools, State Patrol Troopers Association, local American Legion posts and many other venues. The registration fee is \$275 per student and that includes lodging and meals.

Campers will enjoy 6 days and 5 nights of learning and fun. This year, weekly sessions run from the middle of June, until the middle of August. For registration and camp information go to: <http://www.legionville.org>

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ATV riders can explore Minnesota trails for free June 2-4

Minnesotans with an all-terrain vehicle registered for private or agricultural use won't need to pay the additional registration fee (\$53.50 for three years) to ride the state's public ATV trails June 2-4, according to the Department of Natural Resources.

Out-of-state riders can explore Minnesota ATV trails that weekend as well, without the need for a nonresident trail pass (\$21 annually). This is the fourth year that Minnesota is providing ATV riders with free access to more than 3,000 miles of state forest and grant-in-aid trails during "No Registration Weekend."

"We see this weekend as a great opportunity to showcase the wide variety of state and grant-in-aid trails across Minnesota," said Mary Straka, off-highway vehicle program consultant. "There are a large number of privately registered ATVs across the state, and we encourage them to explore the public trails for free June 2-4."

Some great places to start, according to Straka, include:

- The Iron Range Off-Highway Vehicle State Recreation

Area, a 1,200-acre OHV park in Gilbert with 36 miles of scenic trails for riders of all abilities. The recreation area will have special programs, rides and displays on Saturday, June 4.

- The 100-mile trail system in Nemadji State Forest, which connects to the Matthew Lourey State Trail and the Gandy Dancer Trail for more riding opportunities.
- The 29-mile Spider Lake trail system in Foot Hills State Forest, where riders can curve around lakes and ponds, go up and down a variety of hills, and view overlooks from the ridges throughout the forest.
- The 200-mile Northwoods Regional Trail System in Aitkin and Itasca counties, where riders can use the Soo Line Trail to connect to great communities and trail loops.

The DNR advises riders to keep safety in mind when out on the trails. In particular:

- Safety training is required for ATV riders born after July 1, 1987, and it is recommended for everyone that operates an ATV.
- Kids under age 18 must wear a DOT-certified helmet.
- Kids age 16 and under must

fit the ATV they are operating and be able to properly reach and control the handlebars and reach the foot pegs while sitting upright on the ATV.

We have loaner gear and coaches that can teach the game and all events are free to participate in and to be a spectator. We have a revolving door of big time coaches and players helping us out. The best deal in the world for lacrosse programming development is right here."
