More than 270 Attend Garden Valley's 113th Annual Meeting

More than 270 persons, including 215 registered members, were in attendance at the 113th annual membership meeting of Garden Valley Telephone Company d/b/a Garden Valley Technologies held at the Win-E-Mac School auditorium near Erskine on Tuesday, June 5, 2018.

As members registered and received their attendance gift, entertainment was provided by "Caleigh" a northern Minnesota band. Members and guests were also treated to coffee and donuts prior to calling the business meeting to order. A resolution to amend Article III, Section 1 of the By-Laws was voted on and passed. The business meeting included reports from President Jerry Freitag, Treasurer Jim Ferden and CEO/General Manager Tim Brinkman. Corporate Counsel Chuck Fitzgerald

reviewed By-Laws information relating to director qualification and voting; and the election of directors for Districts 3, 6 and 9 was held. Retiring District 6 Director Vernon Hamnes and retiring District 9 Director Ronald Engelstad were recognized for their many years of service on the board of directors. Garden Valley employees were also on hand to answer questions about the cooperative's products and services. Prizes were awarded and lunch was served following adjournment of the meeting. The winner of the adult grand prize, \$250 gift certificate to Garden Valley Technologies, was Charlie Kiesow, of Goodridge, and winning the children's drawing for a 24" bicycle was Joe Phillips, of Bagley.

Directors Elected to Board
Larry Djernes of Clearbrook

was elected to fill the 3-year term as director for District 6 (Clearbrook, Gonvick & Leonard exchanges), and Ron Kiesow of Goodridge was elected to fill the 3-year term as Garden Valley's director for District 9 (Gatzke, Goodridge, Grygla and rural Thief River Falls exchanges). Incumbent Director Arlene Novak of St. Hilaire was re-elected to serve the 3-year term as Garden Valley's director for District 3 (Red Lake Falls & St. Hilaire exchanges).

Following the June 5th annual meeting, Garden Valley's board of directors re-elected the following directors to serve as officers of the cooperative: Jerry Freitag, President, Arlene Novak, Secretary, Bryon Ness, Vice President and Jim Ferden, Treasurer.

Your Legal Rights: Beware of Medicare Card Fraud

Over 55 million people receive Medicare benefits, including about 950,000 Minnesotans. In the past, Medicare cards have included beneficiaries' Social Security Numbers ("SSN") to help identify them and process their claims. To help protect against identity theft, Medicare is issuing new cards without people's SSNs. Unfortunately, scammers are trying to take advantage of the transition to new cards to defraud Medicare beneficiaries.

Changes to the Medicare Card
A federal law requires that SSNs be removed from all Medicare cards by April 2019. The new cards will use a unique "Medicare Beneficiary Identifier" ("MBI") to identify people rather than their SSN. MBIs will have 11 characters, including a combination of numbers and uppercase letters. An example MBI provided by CMS is: 1EG4 TE5-MK73.

What to Know

CMS began sending new Medicare cards to beneficiaries in April 2018 and will continue to do so on a rolling basis until April 2019. New cards are being sent to beneficiaries in waves based, in part, on the state in which they live. According to CMS, Minnesota is in wave three, which will occur sometime after June 2018.

New Medicare cards are sent automatically to beneficiaries. There is no activation process or fee to receive a new card, and beneficiaries do not need to take any action to receive their new card as long as the address they have on file with Social Security is correct. Moreover, CMS states that it will not call beneficiaries and ask them to provide personal or financial information to receive a new Medicare card.

How the Scam Works

New Medicare cards are being issued to prevent fraud, but con artists are already perpetrating new scams in an attempt to take advantage of the process. The scams vary, but typically begin with a phone call from a scammer posing as a representative of Medicare or another government agency, and attempting to get the beneficiary to reveal personal information. Under one variation, scammers ask a beneficiary to pay a processing fee to receive or activate their new Medicare card. The scammer may even threaten to cancel a beneficiary's Medicare benefits if they don't pay the fee.

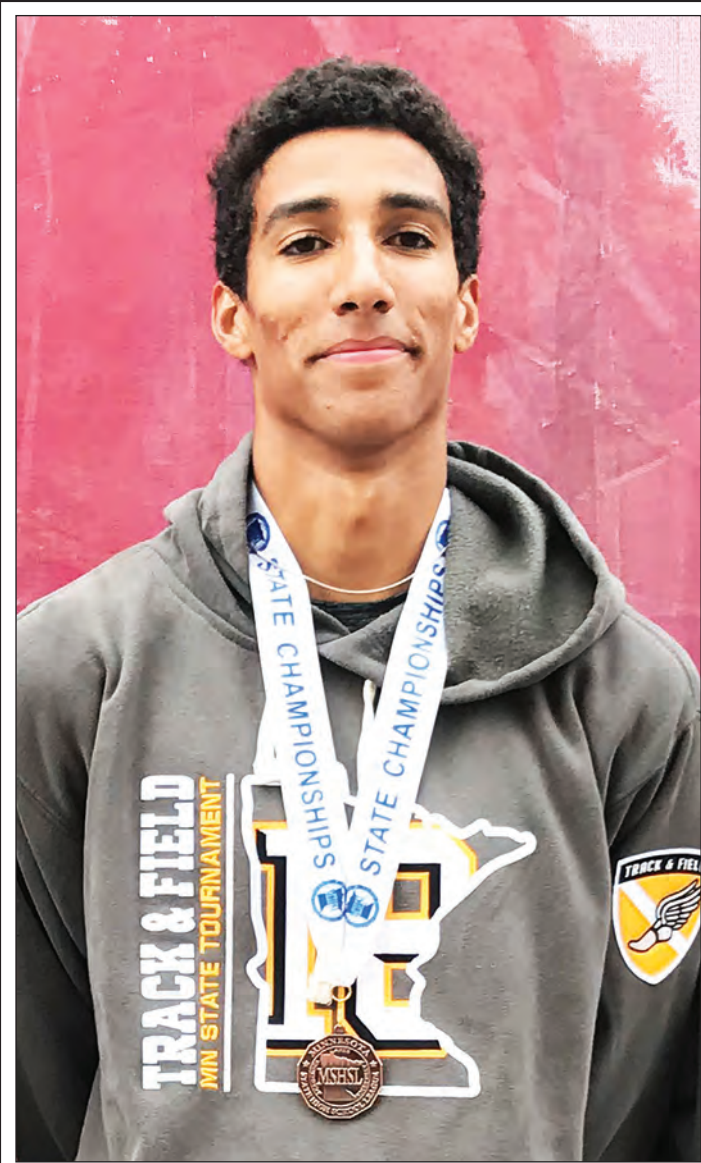

In another variation, the scammer claims that the beneficiary must verify his or her SSN to receive their new Medicare card. The scam artist can use this information to commit identity theft. In yet another variation, the scam artist claims a beneficiary is owed a refund for a transaction on their old card and asks the beneficiary for his or her bank account information to process the supposed refund. The scammer can use this information to drain the beneficiary's bank account.

Who to Contact

If you receive a suspicious call, hang up and report the incident to CMS by calling (800) 633-4227. People targeted by this scam are also encouraged to report the matter to the Federal Bureau of Investigation by calling (763) 569-8000 and the Federal Trade Commission by calling (877) 382-4357.

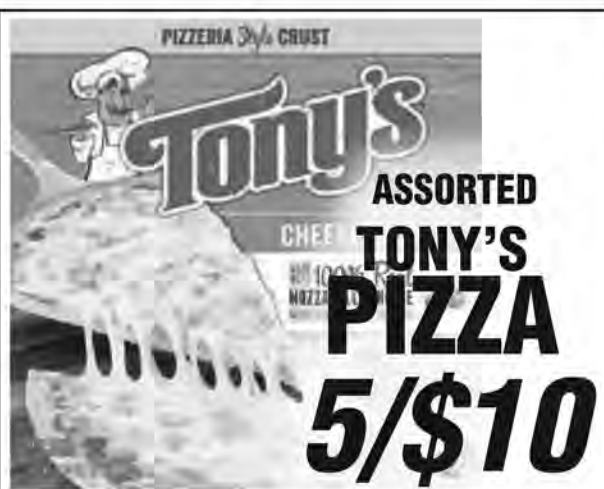

Statement by Agriculture Committee Ranking Member Collin Peterson on Senate Farm Bill

House Agriculture Committee Ranking Member Collin Peterson of Minnesota welcomed farm bill text released by the Senate Committee on Agriculture, Nutrition, and Forestry last week. In a statement on the eve of Committee markup, Peterson applauded the Senate for its bipartisan approach and expressed hope that the House would bring a similarly biparti-

san bill to conference:

"What the Senate has put together reflects great work by Chairman Roberts and Ranking Member Stabenow to set partisan goals aside and focus on a bill that addresses the issues we've heard about throughout this farm bill process. Pat and Debbie had a tough job considering the tight limits on the money they could use to write a

new bill. They put a bill together that avoids poison pills, stays away from ideology on SNAP, and most importantly, should be able to get the votes to pass their chamber.

"I will support the certain things I can get behind in the Senate bill once we get to conference. Frankly, I'd like to be able to vote for a House bill. But right now, the Majority's language

can only get Republican votes. That doesn't stack up to the bipartisan proposal that our Senate colleagues have put together, so we should come back to the drawing board and match their effort. My staff and I are available and eager to engage. That's how we can get a product we know can become law and give our farmers and consumers the certainty they need."
