The Red River Watershed Management Board Provides Regional Water Management Solutions

Many people have heard of the Red River Watershed Management Board (RRWMB) but may not know who they are or what they do. The RRWMB is one of many organizations working on water management in the Red River Basin (RRB), and this may add to some of the confusion about water management entities in the RRB. The RRWMB has taxing authority similar to a county, township, or school district, but most people do not know what the taxes are used for. This article is intended to help provide some answers about the who, what, where, when, and why of the RRWMB.

The RRWMB is comprised of 7 watershed districts on the Minnesota side of the Red River. These include the Bois de Sioux, Joe River, Middle-Snake-Tamarac Rivers, Red Lake River, Roseau River, Two Rivers, and Wild Rice Watershed Districts. Each watershed district has one representative on the Board, which meets monthly. The RRWMB was formed by the MN Legislature in 1976 with the main purpose of reducing flooding on the Red River and its tributaries.

The mission of the RRWMB is to institute, coordinate, and finance projects and programs to alleviate flooding and assure the beneficial use of water in the watershed of the Red River of the North and its tributaries. The principal objective of the RRWMB is to assist member watershed districts with the implementation of water related projects and programs. The

purpose of these is the reduction of local and mainstem flood damages and to enhance environmental and water resource management. To qualify for funding, projects and programs must be of benefit to the whole Red River Basin. The RRWMB has 11 supporting objectives that help guide its efforts and includes the following:

- Coordination – Provide leadership for water management.
- Financial Support – Fund initiatives that encourage consideration of mainstem Red River benefits and enhance environmental and water resources.
- Basin Planning – Assist local, state, regional, national and international efforts through coordination and assistance with implementation.
- Water Quantity – Alleviate flood damages and maintain low flow conditions for the aquatic environment and water supply.
- Water Quality – Assistance for studies, programs, initiatives, and projects to improve water quality.
- Erosion and Sedimentation – Assistance for studies, programs, and initiatives to reduce soil erosion and sedimentation.
- Education – Development of educational programs related to water and natural resource management concerns.
- Research – Assistance for basic and applied research related to natural resource management within the RRB.
- Public Information – Inform the public of water management activities.
- Conflict Resolution – Work toward resolution of conflicts regarding water management.
- Policies, Rules, Regulations – Comply with policies and regulations of other governmental entities.

Flood control is high on the list of projects and the RRWMB has provided funding for over 40 impoundment projects in the RRB since the late 1970s. These projects provide nearly 200,000-acre feet of storage (one-acre foot is the area covered by one acre to a depth of one foot and this equals 325,851 gallons of

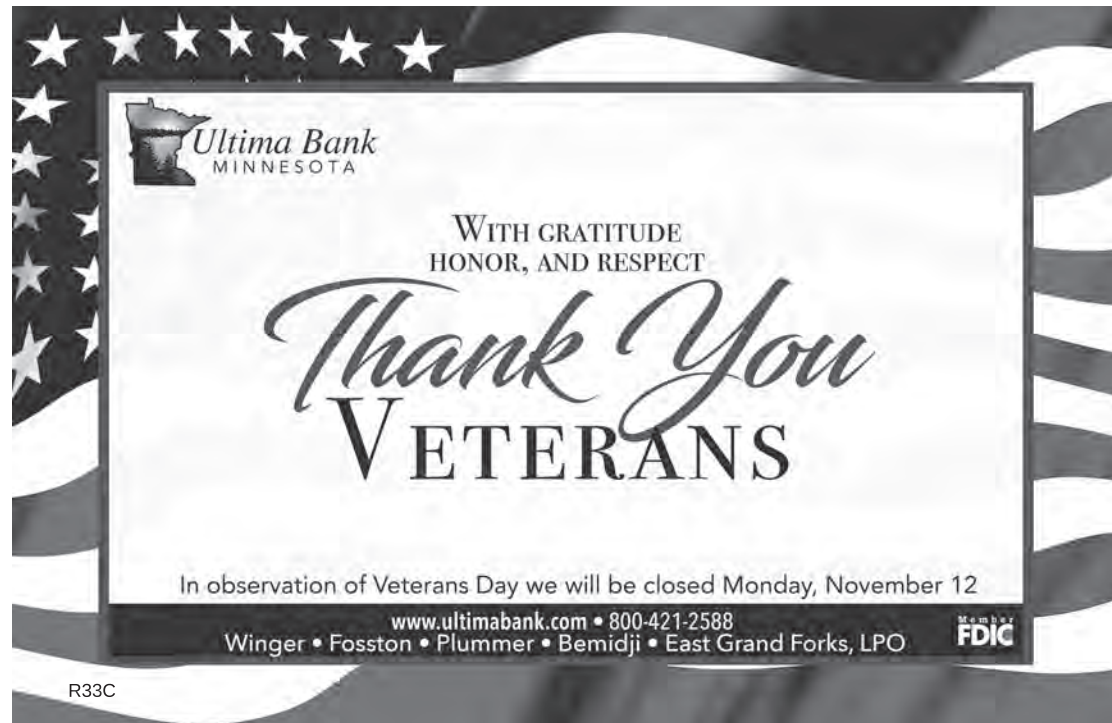

water). These projects provide significant flood control, and at the same time provide environmental benefits by restoring wetlands, providing water quality benefits, and providing wildlife habitat. Funding for projects is from a tax levy collected through member watershed districts. One half of this levy is utilized locally for local projects, and one-half is sent to the RRWMB for regional projects.

The RRWMB not only is a funding source, but it is a resource for research and information. It has sponsored and provided information for many studies that are of value to local water resource managers. These include surface water drainage and ditching, lidar data collection and dissemination, permitting issues, hydrologic and hydraulic studies, and water quality data collection.

Many partnerships have been developed since 1976, and the RRRMB works closely with the Red River Basin Commission, the Red River Retention Authority, the North Dakota Joint Water Resources Board, and others. These entities work toward the common goals of flooding, drainage, and water management. An annual conference is sponsored by the RRWMB each spring to coordinate and share information.

In short, the RRWMB is dedicated to providing leadership, guidance, and solutions for managing water in the RRB. 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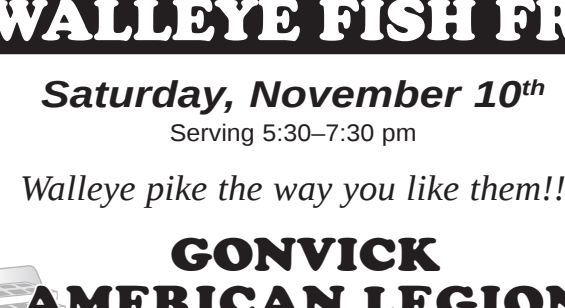

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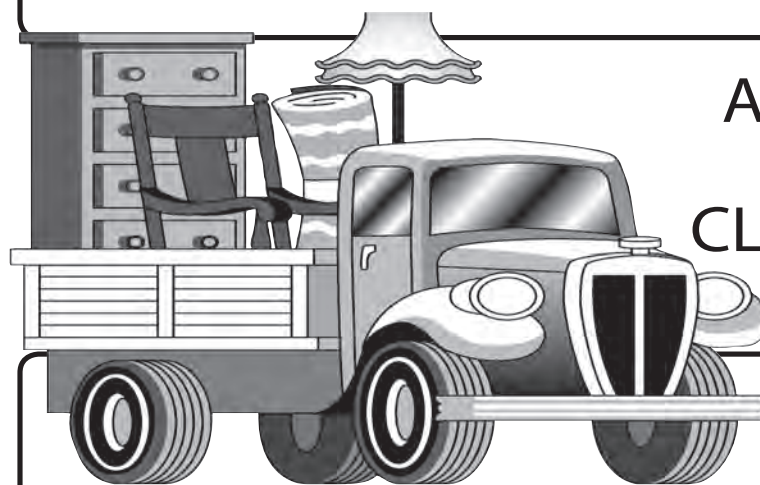

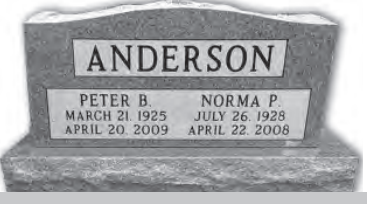
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OBITUARIES

Peterson, Yoho, and Marshall lead letter in support of regulatory flexibility for livestock haulers

Representatives Collin Peterson (D-MN), Ted Yoho (R-FL), and Roger Marshall (R-KS) submitted a bipartisan letter to the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) in support of a petition to waive livestock haulers from certain provisions of Hours of Service (HOS) rules. The petition, which was submitted by the National Cattlemen's Beef Association (NCBA), Livestock Marketing Association (LMA), American Farm Bureau Federation (AFBF), American Beekeeping Federation (ABF), American Honey Producers Association (AHPA), and National Aquaculture Association (NAA), requests increased driving hours for livestock haulers in exchange for additional training designed by FMCSA.

The letter was signed by 59 members of Congress from both sides of the aisle.

"Current hours of service regulations do not accommodate

the unique needs of livestock haulers," said Congressman Peterson. "This petition will allow them to deliver agricultural products to market more effectively while maintaining their proven record of safety."

"The safe transportation of livestock is an essential part of feeding America," said Congressman Yoho. "This petition would modify the current regulations so we protect the safety of both haulers and livestock in route to their final destination. I want to thank Congressman Peterson, Congressman Marshall, and all my colleagues who lead this bipartisan letter in support of the petition to provide relief for livestock haulers."

"Livestock haulers across the country have the difficult task of ensuring motorist safety while also tending to the health and welfare of the animals transported," said Congressman Marshall. "I was proud to support this petition that works to address a livestock haulers unique tasks, while also maintaining their strong safety record."

"When livestock and other live animals are transported, it's important to get them to their destination safely and without delay or disruption," said Zippy Duvall, President of the American Farm Bureau Federation. "Safety for the driver and others on the road is a priority. That is why we are petitioning DOT to adopt modern fatigue-management practices that provide the same or greater level of safety while avoiding unintended and unnecessary stress on the animals entrusted to our care. We greatly appreciate Reps. Yoho, Peterson, Marshall and the other Members of Congress who wrote DOT in support of the petition."

"We're very thankful to Congressmen Peterson, Yoho, Marshall, and others for helping lead the effort to bring some common sense and flexibility to the Hours of Service rules that govern livestock haulers," said Kevin Kester, fifth-generation California rancher and Presi-

"The small but mighty beekeeping industry hauls managed honeybees clear across the country to pollinate crops like almonds, apples, pears and blueberries," said Kelvin Adee, President of the American Honey Producers Association. "These bees are responsible for nearly \$20 billion in American agricultural output annually. Without changes to the existing hours of services rules for bee haulers, our drivers would be forced to rest unnecessarily long periods of time while the sun is up and the bees are at risk of overheating and dying. We believe that the petition we submitted alongside other livestock interests strikes the critical balance between ensuring the health of our nation's already imperiled managed bees and the safety of our roads. We applaud Representatives Peterson, Yoho, and Marshall for writing in support of this petition."

"As beekeepers, we are well aware of the importance of managed honey bees to our food source," said Tim May, President of the American Beekeeping Federation. "Nearly one-third of the food we eat is pollinated by honey bees. Due to the increased demand for honey bee pollination, livestock haulers are transporting bees all across the country. Extending the HOS for livestock haulers gives bee haulers the added time needed to coordinate with the required daylight driving schedule. We at ABF understand that safety is always the number one priority and we commend the new safety requirements suggested for livestock haulers."

Zebra mussels confirmed in Lake Bemidji in Beltrami County

The Minnesota Department of Natural Resources (DNR) has confirmed zebra mussels in Lake Bemidji in Beltrami County.

In July, an adult zebra mussel was found in the stomach contents of a perch caught by a Lake Bemidji State Park volunteer while fishing on the north shore. DNR investigations at that time, including diving and sampling for zebra mussel larvae, did not lead to conclusive evidence.

Zebra mussels were recently confirmed during planned dock and lift inspections. A Beltrami County aquatic invasive species specialist found individual adult zebra mussels on the Northwoods public access dock and on a dock near a resort on the south side of the lake.

Lakes connected to Lake Bemidji by navigable waters will also be listed as infested. These include Lake Marquette, Carr Lake, Lake Irving, Stump Lake and the stretch of the Mis-

sissippi River from Stump Lake to Wolf Lake.

"The DNR appreciates the help of Beltrami County staff who partnered with us to look for zebra mussels in Lake Bemidji," DNR Invasive Species Unit Supervisor Heidi Wolf said. "The diligent work of Beltrami County and our other partners around the state is invaluable."

It is important to carefully check docks, boat lifts and other equipment being removed for the season and to contact the

DNR if you think you've found an invasive species that is new to a lake. Minnesota law requires keeping docks and lifts out of the water for at least 21 days before putting them into another body of water.

The DNR recommends these steps for lake property owners:

- Look on the posts, wheels and underwater support bars of docks and lifts, as well as any parts of boats, pontoons and rafts that may have been submerged in water for an extended period.
- Hire DNR-permitted lake service provider businesses to install or remove boats, docks, lifts and other water-related equipment. These businesses have received training on Minnesota's aquatic invasive species laws and many have experience identifying and removing invasive species.
- People should contact their area aquatic invasive species specialist if they think they have discovered an invasive species that has not already been confirmed in a lake. Take a photo of any newly discovered invasive species before removing it from equipment. Save specimens or leave them in place until the DNR can investigate.
