## House Republicans Applaud PUC Line 3 Votes

ST. PAUL, MN—The Minnesota Public Utilities Commission met Monday at the Minnesota Senate Building in Saint Paul to continue the September meeting that had been postponed following protests. The commissioners reaffirmed their previous 5-0 vote to grant the certificate of need for the Enbridge Line 3 replacement project and rejected a motion brought by pipeline opponents to reconsider the certificate of need, allowing the project to continue through Minnesota's regulatory process.

House Speaker Kurt Daudt, R-Crown, issued the following statement regarding today's PUC meeting:

"I applaud the PUC's decision to allow the project to move forward, and it's my hope we can work with the Walz administration to keep the Line 3 replacement on track. We have high regulatory stan-

dards in place, and the project should be allowed to proceed so Minnesota can enjoy the enhanced environmental protection, property tax revenue and good-paying jobs that will be generated by this project."

House Jobs & Energy Committee Chair Rep. Pat Garofalo, R-Farmington, and House Environment and Natural Resources Committee Chair Rep. Dan Fabian, R-Roseau, added the following joint statement:

"The PUC made the right decision today, standing up to the protesters who sought to shut down the meeting and derail the regulatory process we have in place. We are encouraged that Governor-elect Walz agreed 'we need to follow the process in place' and expect his administration will not throw up unnecessary roadblocks that would further delay this project."

## Polk-Norman-Mahnomen Community Health Services: Recipient of the Gold Loving Support Award for Excellence 2018 from USDA

Breastfeeding promotion and support is a WIC priority for USDA, as it is for the Minnesota WIC program. Local WIC agencies have made tremendous strides in providing information and support to all pregnant and breastfeeding women participating in WIC. Locally, the Polk-Norman-Mahnomen Community Health Services (CHS) was awarded a grant in 2016 to enhance Breastfeeding Services and support with the implementation of the WIC Breastfeeding Peer Counselor Program. Many new mothers turn to other moms just like them to share experiences. When new moms have someone who understands what they have been through, it makes it easier to cope with the questions and challenges of being a new parent. WIC breastfeeding peer counselors are mothers in the community with personal breastfeeding experience who give information and support to new moms. The focus of the WIC Program is to improve the health of mothers, infants,

and children. Breastfeeding is one of the most important ways to ensure that babies get a healthy start in life. Mother's milk has the perfect combination of nutrients babies need to grow and develop. Human milk has more than 200 nutrients in the perfect combination of fats, sugar, and protein to help babies grow healthy and strong. The use of breastfeeding peer counselors adds a critical dimension to WIC's efforts to help women initiate and continue breastfeeding. WIC breastfeeding peer counselors provide a valuable service to their communities, addressing the barriers to breastfeeding by offering breastfeeding education, support, and role modeling. Peer counselors are familiar with the resources available to WIC clients, have familiarity with the questions a new breastfeeding mother may ask, and recognize when to refer mothers to other resources during critical periods when mothers may experience difficulty.

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Breastfeeding is so important that the United States has set national objectives for breastfeeding as part of our Healthy People 2020 goals. Minnesota has already accomplished these goals but rates do suggest that mothers may not be getting all the support they need. A breastfeeding peer counselor can help mothers choose to breastfeed and help her continue to breastfeed longer.

"Over time, mother-to-mother support has proven to be one of the most successful approaches to encourage mothers to breastfeed their babies," said Tammy Conn IBCLC, P-N-M CHS Breastfeeding Peer Counselor Coordinator. "WIC Breastfeeding Peer Counselors are role models breastfeeding their babies and talking about their experiences."

Each year USDA announces the Loving Support Awards for Excellence. The award program recognizes WIC local agency Breastfeeding Peer Programs that have provided exemplary breastfeeding support to women they serve. Local WIC Agencies are invited to submit an application describing their peer program and providing data demonstrating its effectiveness. This year Polk-Norman-Mahnomen CHS applied, met the criteria and received the "Loving Support Gold Award for excellence".

### Structure Fire

On 11-14-18 the Polk County Sheriff's Office was dispatched to 29808 270th Ave Sw approximately 3 miles west of Crookston for a house fire. It was reported that smoke was coming from the attic with flames coming from a hole around the chimney area. Deputy's arrived and the property owner Steven Barlow and his family had safely exited the home without injuries. Crookston Fire later arrived and were able to extinguish the fire. The home sustained moderate damage. The fire was investigated and appeared to have been started by the wood stove chimney in the attic area. Assisting agencies were Crookston Fire Department and Crookston Area Ambulance.

## Structure fire, rural McIntosh

On 11/12/2018, the Polk County Sheriff's Office responded to a report of a pole barn on fire in section 32 of Lessor Township. Deputies responded and investigated the scene and did not see any signs of arson. It is believed that the fire was started from an old stock tank heater which was accidentally activated when the property owner flipped a breaker to the pole barn unintentionally. The property owner was identified as Gerald M Shaver, age 65, of rural McIntosh.

McIntosh Fire Department also responded to the fire, but the pole barn was a total loss. No one was injured as a result of the fire and the fire did not spread.

There were no other responding agencies besides McIntosh Fire Department and the Polk County Sheriff's Office.

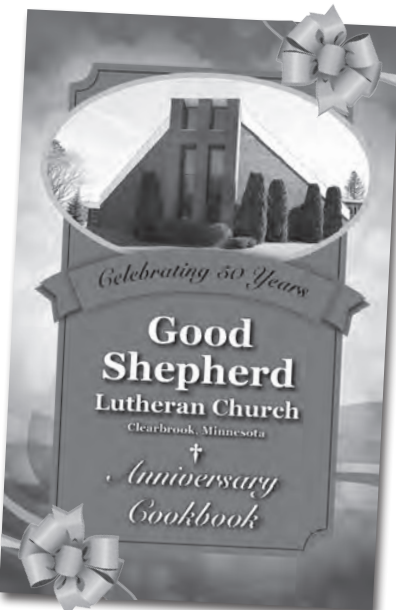

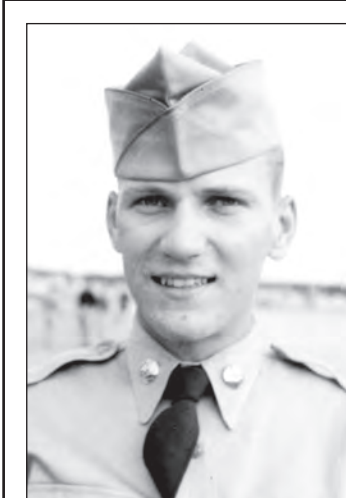

Entrance fees to all 75 Minnesota state parks and recreation areas will be waived on Friday, November 23, 2018

ST. PAUL, MN – Governor Mark Dayton today announced "Free Park Friday" in Minne-sota, highlighting that entrance fees to all Minnesota state parks and recreation areas will be waived on Friday, November 23, 2018. Governor Dayton encourages all Minnesotans to enjoy the outdoors with family and friends on the day after Thanksgiving.

"I wish everyone in Minneso-ta a very happy Thanksgiving, and recommend visiting one of Minnesota's beautiful state parks — for free — on Friday," said Governor Mark Dayton. "Like sharing a meal, going for a walk can be a great way to spend quality time with family and friends."

Research shows that spend-ing time outdoors benefits chil-dren and adults, including improving mood, enhancing creative thinking and problem solving, promoting a conserva-tion ethic, and improving physi-cal fitness. On Thanksgiving Day, the average American consumes around 4,500 calories. A brisk walk can burn about 300 calories in one hour.

"Holidays can be stressful, but Minnesota state parks and recreation areas are open year-round to provide places to unwind and relax, surrounded by natural beauty," said Erika Rivers, director of Minnesota State Parks and Trails. "We hope that visitors who go to a state park for the first time on Free Park Friday will have fun, feel refreshed, and want to come back."

Although most state park of-fices and visitor centers will be unstaffed or minimally staffed on Free Park Friday, a variety of on-site and online resources available for visitors:

- Look for the self-orienta-tion signs near the park en-trance for suggestions on what to see and do during your visit.

- Additional hike recommen-dations can be found online at the Free Park Friday page.

- Pick up a hard-copy map at the park office or, better yet, download one of the new GeoP-Df maps that show you where you are based on your mobile device's built-in GPS receiver. Internet access is needed to in-stall the app and map files, but once they are installed, they do not need Internet access or cell phone service to function.

A few Minnesota state parks will offer special programs. Ex-amples include:

- Feeling Full Hike – 10-11:30 a.m. at Sibley State Park in New London. Join a natu-ralist on a hike to Mt. Tom, with some stops along the way to learn about our feathered friend: the turkey. Meet at the Interpretive Center.

- Turkey Hike – 1-2 p.m. at Whitewater State Park near Winona. Learn the fascinating history of the wild turkey in the Whitewater Valley! Meet at the visitor center for a brief introduction, then take a hike to look for signs of wild turkeys.

- Bison Tales – 1-2 p.m. at Blue Mounds State Park in Laverne. Join a naturalist to learn more about efforts to conserve bison throughout the state. Touch real pieces of bison, practice your bison commu-nication skills, and make a bison storybook of your very own to take home. Meet at the picnic shelter in the cart-in campsite area.

## Peterson speaks on House Floor in support of De-Listing Gray Wolves

WASHINGTON – Congressman Collin C. Peterson spoke this morning on the House Floor in support of H.R. 6784, the Manage Our Wolves Act.

"I rise in support of the bill. I have to say in my 28 years in this body I have never seen so much nonsense, misinformation, and propaganda put out on a bill as being put out on this one," Peterson says in the start of his speech. "We followed the Endangered Species Act. We did what was said, the scientists said we recovered and they delisted the wolves. These were scientists that did it, it wasn't any politician. You had a group out there, these extreme environmentalists and others who have captured our party, went to a judge in Washington D.C. that has no idea what's going on at all and convinced that judge that the wolves had not recovered because they had not been reestablished all the way to Des Moines, Iowa."

One of the first bills introduced in the 115th Congress was Congressman Peterson's bill to delist gray wolves from federal protections in Minnesota, Wisconsin, Michigan and Wyoming, and return their management to state agencies. His bill, the Gray Wolf State Management Act, passed earlier this year through the House Committee on Natural Resources on a bipartisan vote.

Section 2 of today's legislation also would delist gray wolves in Minnesota, Wisconsin, Michigan, and Wyoming. The underlying bill passed 196-180 on a bipartisan vote, and now awaits Senate action.
