The Minnesota Beef Council is excited to announce that the 2018 Minnesota Beef “Prime Promoter of the Year” has been awarded to the Marshall County Agricultural Association.

This award was presented at the 2018 Minnesota Cattle Industry Convention this past

year. Each year, they host a beef cook-off at their county fair where contestants cook prime rib using their own method of cooking, marinating and seasoning.

Besides their county fair beef cook-off event, the association purchases local beef to auction off in bundles during the AgBash, which is a fair fundraiser. The beef bundles include hamburger patties, beef roasts, chuck roasts and New York Strip. In addition, ribeye steaks are served for dinner.

The Marshall County Agricultural Association believes that agricultural education and tradition is vital to their community.

They received a \$500 award to be used for beef promotions throughout the coming year, as well as their name engraved on the “Prime Promoter of the Year” plaque.

MFU applauds Farm Bill signing; calls for more work on trade, consolidation and health care

ST. PAUL – Today, President Trump signed the final conference report of the 2018 Agricultural Improvement Act, or Farm Bill. This comes the week after the U.S. House of Representatives passed the Farm Bill by a 369-47 margin and the U.S. Senate passed it 87-13.

Minnesota Farmers Union (MFU), a grassroots family farm organization, is pleased that the bill has become law, as it provides more certainty for fam-

ily farmers. The bill contains an improved dairy program and keeps crop insurance well intact, providing farmers more flexibility to choose between programs. It also keeps funding for conservation, beginning farmer and local food programs.

As MFU members passed a special order at November's 77th Annual MFU Convention calling for passage of the Farm Bill during the lame-duck session, this action is incredibly important to the organization.

Statement from Chair Fabian on Department of Commerce Line 3 Appeal

Roseau, MN—Rep. Dan Fabian, R-Roseau, Chair of the House Environment and Natural Resources Committee, issued the following statement regarding today's appeal filed by the Minnesota Department of Commerce aiming to block the Enbridge Line 3 replacement pipeline.

"It's outrageous that our lame duck governor is using his last days in office to launch a desperate attempt to derail the Line 3 pipeline project and the thousands of jobs, millions in property tax revenue, and environmental protection that comes with it. This project has met every legal hurdle and was unanimously approved by the governor's own appointees on the Public Utilities Commission. This unnecessary and politically-motivated attack is a waste of taxpayer dollars and needs to be reversed.

"Recently I personally spoke to Governor-elect Walz, and urged him not to interfere with the Line 3 project—I hope the Governor-elect will do the right thing and instruct his Commerce Commissioner to drop this appeal as soon as he is sworn in next month."

Last month, state regulators at the Public Utilities Commission voted unanimously to reaffirm their previous decision to allow the project to proceed.

Polk County Public Health Receives Breastfeeding Friendly Award

Crookston, Minnesota — Polk County Public Health has received a Breastfeeding Friendly Health Department Silver Level Award from the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) for its contributions to the health of mothers and their babies. The designation acknowledges a county health department's commitment to acting as a model for the community by supporting healthy families and receiving the business benefits of supporting nursing mothers.

Breastfeeding is a foundational way to ensure that babies receive optimal nutrition during the first formative years of life. Studies show that infants who are breastfed have better health outcomes as they grow.

"Breastfeeding has many health benefits ranging from nutrition to long-term protection from disease. We are working to create and support a culture where breastfeeding is the norm and to reduce obstacles that women and families face, and breastfeeding friendly places are a great way to do that. We are dedicated to supporting mothers, babies and families in their breastfeeding journey," said Sarah Reese, Director, Polk County Public Health.

MDH's Breastfeeding Friendly recognition program is supported by the state Women, Infants and Children program (WIC) and the Statewide Health Improvement Partnership (SHIP). Awards are designated at gold, silver and bronze levels, which correspond to the number of steps an organization has met in a 10-step process.

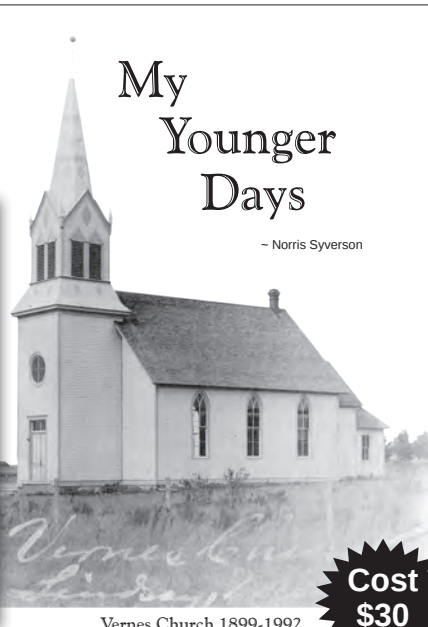
Here is just an excerpt from his first page...

I was born in the front room of the house I now live in on December 24, 1933. This part of the house is log. It was covered with some kind of pressed green paper about 1/8th of an inch thick, now it is covered with ½ inch thick celotex.

This house had only two rooms downstairs, each one about 12 feet by 14 feet, with low ceilings about 7 ½ feet high....There were 5 boys and 5 girls aging from 1 year to 16 years old, plus Ma and Pa living in this small house at that time....
