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Minnesota State Patrol

The Minnesota State Patrol says a 77-year-old Bagley, Minnesota man is dead after a Clearwater County crash Friday morning, May 7, 2015.

Shortly before 9 a.m. Friday, the state patrol says a Chevy Impala was traveling eastbound on Clearwater County Road 27 when it ran a stop sign and broadsided a Buick Park Avenue traveling north on State Highway 92.

The driver of the Buick, identified as Milo Fultz, was killed in the crash. He was the only occupant in his car.

The driver of the Chevy, identified as 65-year-old Sally Littlewolf of Waubun, was se-

riously injured. Two children in that car – ages 10 Janelle Potter and 4 Jack Littlewolf – suffered non-life threatening injuries.

Essentia Health-Fosston Invests in Ambulance Patient Care

Essentia Health-Fosston has just purchased a special ventilator to be used in ambulances for patient care. The purchase comes as a result of the generous donations received from Giving Hearts Day 2015, a 24-hour online fundraiser created by the Dakota Medical Foundation.

The addition of the transfer ventilator with its advanced monitoring levels and technology means ambulance crews can transfer patients to the hospital using features that were otherwise unavailable.

“This means improved care for the vented patient,” ex-

plains Rich Dutcher, Essentia Health-Fosston’s EMS manager. “With more capabilities from the ventilator, the ambulance crew has more resources available for the patient in need of such respiratory interventions. By using the transfer ventilator, the patient has a higher chance at a better respiratory outcome.”

In addition to advanced monitoring, the ventilator’s technology allows Emergency Medical Services crews to assist the patient in breathing, or will even completely breath for the patient if needed in some situations.

Highway 32 detour between Thief River Falls and Middle River begins May 18

BEMIDJI, Minn. – Motorists on Highway 32 in northwestern Minnesota will experience a detour beginning Monday, May 18, as work begins on Highway 32 between Thief River Falls and Middle River.

The detour southbound on Highway 32 from Middle River will follow Marshall CSAH 6 west seven miles to Marshall CSAH 8, where traffic will proceed south for six miles. Motorists will then make a short 1/10 mile jog on Marshall CSAH 28 west to Newfolden, where they will take Highway 59 south to Thief River Falls.

The detour is expected to conclude in mid-to-late August, with the entire project concluding in late September, weather permitting.

This extensive project will see pavement rehabilitation of 21 miles of roadway between Thief River Falls and Middle River, the replacement of culverts and urban reconstruction within the city of Middle River.

Drivers are urged to slow down to posted speeds in the work zones.

Once they are connected to your computer, they either damage or delete your files. They then tell you that you owe them between \$100 - \$300 to retrieve the information and put it back onto your computer.

If anyone gets a call like this, DO NOT follow any of their instructions. Tell them that you are contacting the Sheriff’s Office and hang up.

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DUST CONTROL - POLK COUNTY ROADS

The Polk County Highway Department is accepting requests for application of calcium chloride for dust control in front of residences that lie along County or Township gravel roads. Grow a Healthy, No-waste Lawn and Garden

The Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA) has offered the following tips on how you should care for all of the green and growing things in your yard that can have a big impact on and how much waste your household creates, and on air and water quality. From grass trimmings and leaves to pesticides and water, the eco-impact of your lawn and garden can be significant.

Your lawn and garden's effect on the environment.

Your lawn and garden can add a lot to what your household needs to discard and recycle. Yard waste and food waste make up 13 percent of what's thrown into the garbage in Minnesota.

Healthy lawns and gardens can be maintained in ways that produce less waste, and you can easily manage what's left by composting at home. A healthy lawn and garden can naturally resist weeds and pests. You don't need a lot of chemicals to keep your yard looking green. Learn to read the signs and find out what's really wrong with your plants. Solve your lawn and garden problems by applying some brainpower before you use pesticides and herbicides.

Mow, fertilize, and rake less.

You don't have to spend so much time maintaining your lawn. Sound incredible? Mowing, watering, fertilizing and raking it less and using no pesticides may be your way to a healthy, environmentally friendly yard.

Mow your grass to a height of 2 ½ to 3 inches.

This is the single most important thing you can do to improve the health of your lawn. By keeping your grass a little longer, the roots grow deeper and can reach more water during dry periods. Longer grass also helps shade the soil surface, making it harder for weeds to get established.

Use a sharp mower blade when cutting your lawn to make it less susceptible to disease.

Leave grass clippings on the lawn.

Grass clippings can provide the equivalent of about one application of fertilizer per year. Sweep your sidewalk, driveway, or street so clippings don't pollute nearby lakes or streams.

Test your soil to determine the right mix of fertilizer for your lawn. You may need less than you think. The University of Minnesota Soil Testing Lab

Wait before you water.

In Minnesota, most grass can survive without watering, although it may enter a dormant "brown" stage during the summer. Water only when it hasn't rained for at least seven days. You don't need to water on a routine basis. To get the most water to the plant and reduce evaporation:

- Water early in the morning. Grass blades need to dry out to minimize disease.
- Water close to the ground.
- Water slowly, deeply, and less frequently. Root growth is influenced by water depth and time of the year. Frequent shallow watering that keeps surface soils wet encourages shallow root growth, greater proneness to certain diseases, and reduced stress tolerance.
- Only water grass. Make sure water is not lost by landing on or running off the grass onto hard, impervious surfaces.

Aerate your lawn if soil is compacted or there is significant thatch build-up. You can do this by using a lawn aerator available from most rental stores. Use the type that removes small cores of soil from the ground and places them on the lawn surface. Leave the cores to decompose naturally, contributing to a decrease in thatch, while the holes poked into the ground help improve soil aeration for healthier root systems.

What are your weeds telling you?

Weeds can tell you something about what's wrong with your lawn. Take time to identify your weeds and treat them appropriately to strengthen and improve your lawn. A weed-free lawn is not necessarily a healthy one.

- Plantain may indicate the soil is compacted or poorly drained.
- Creeping Charlie may indicate the site is too shady or the soil is poorly drained.
- Dandelions may indicate that the grass is too thin.
- Moss may indicate that the site is too shady or too wet for grass to survive.

Ask a Trooper

Question: I plan on travelling to Iowa in about a month to visit a friend, there is a possibility of going trap shooting while I am down there and I was thinking of bringing a shotgun down with me. Are there any laws against transporting a shotgun that I should be aware of, and what actions should I take to ensure that I won't find myself in any trouble?



arm is unloaded, and neither the firearm nor any ammunition being transported is readily accessible or is directly accessible from the passenger compartment of such transporting vehicle: Provided, that in the case of a vehicle without a compartment separate from the driver's compartment the firearm or ammunition shall be contained in a locked container other than the glove compartment or console.

Answer: Minnesota State Statute 97B.045 talks about the transportation of firearms. A person may not transport a firearm in a motor vehicle unless the firearm is:

- (1) unloaded and in a gun case expressly made to contain a firearm, and the case fully encloses the firearm by being zipped, snapped, buckled, tied, or otherwise fastened, and without any portion of the firearm exposed;
- (2) unloaded and in the closed trunk of a motor vehicle; or
- (3) a handgun carried in compliance with sections (624.714 and 624.715 which talks about permits.)

I would advise checking with Iowa on their law but my understanding is that the Federal Law above would apply to that. Good luck and stay safe!

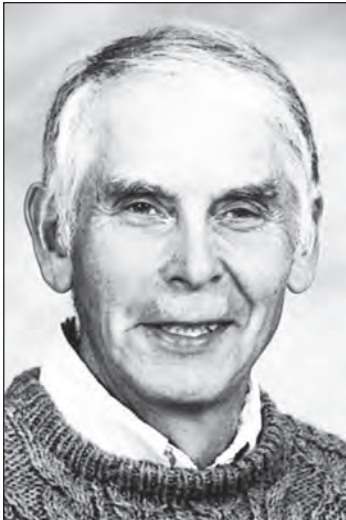

It is important for Minnesotans to know how to spot a stroke quickly and call 9-1-1. You can recognize the signs and symptoms of a stroke by remembering F.A.S.T. F – facial droop/numbness, A – arm weakness, S – speech difficulty, and T – time to call 9-1-1.

Giving Kids a Head Start

Participation in high-quality early learning programs, such as Head Start, is proven to greatly increase the number of children who start school ready to learn and succeed. When Minnesota's kids have the best start possible, entering school fully prepared, everyone benefits. Recent data demonstrates that children receiving Head Start services are approximately 8 months ahead of children the same age that have not received Head Start services.

Inter-County Community Council Head Start currently serves 176 families. We have 23 Head Start staff working throughout our 3 program options.

Head Start is a high quality preschool program serving income eligible families with young children ages birth-5. We are dedicated to improving school readiness and engaging parents, families and the community. The comprehensive program focuses on education, health, social/emotional health, nutrition, and family services. Children receive developmental, social/emotional screenings, and age appropriate educational assessments to monitor their progress toward school readiness.

Based on screenings and family requests, Head Start works with families to provide referrals for additional services, such as financial services, social/emotional health and special education. Head Start works with numerous community partners to provide programming using local resources that are the most beneficial to our families.

Head Start promotes proper, preventative health and dental care through regular well child check-ups, dental exams, age appropriate immunizations, and treatment for identified health needs. Head Start staff work with families to identify community resources to receive these services.

ICCC Head Start has several program options that can benefit families with preschool children.

Home Based Option

Your family home is a rich environment, full of learning opportunities. Our home based program offers a teacher to come to your home for weekly visits. Our teachers will assist you in identifying these learning opportunities and using them to the fullest. They also provide opportunities for events to allow you and your child to interact with other families. This option is offered throughout our service area.

Center Based Option

As children near the kindergarten age, we offer a classroom based option for families



with 4 year old children. This option is available in Thief River Falls and Bagley. Children attend our classroom 4 half days per week, including riding the school bus if transportation is needed. This option also offers regular family events for you and your child.

Combination Based Option

This provides a combination of our other two options for 4 year olds in the school districts of Win-E-Mac, Clearbrook-Gonvick, Fosston, and Red Lake County Central-Oklee.

Children attend two days of classroom each week, but also get home visits every other week to maximize their learning opportunities within the home. This option also provides opportunities for family events for you and your child.
