Cider-making event tantalizes the taste buds of Garden Club and guests

The local Garden Club and guests from Clearbrook, Shevlin, and the surrounding Bagley area recently had the opportunity of

seeing first-hand what goes into cider-making at the home of Jeff and Angie Ness, who live in rural Bagley.

They started by washing the

apples, using mostly Prairie Magic apples, a large, round blush apple, and some Breakers, an older, hardy variety which originated in Ontario, Canada. Other varieties good for cider-making are Harlsons, Hazen, Dogos, a crab apple which are egg-shaped. Some of what he calls ugly apples are good for pressing.

"A good combination is to use 10-30 percent crab apples, and 70 percent of the other varieties. I try hard to get all the leaves out, but I don't care about the core or the stems," Jeff says. I fill up the sink, about two gallons of apples at a time. They oxidize very fast and turn brown once ground up."

His high class venture uses a 3/4 horse power garbage disposal rigged on a sink, which grinds up the apples and empties the pulp out into a bucket below. It becomes a puree the consistency of applesauce, unlike the older method of just crushing the apples.

"Puree is better than crushing (or grinding). This way you get every bit of the juice out of the apples when I press them," Jeff

said. "I fill the press one-half to three-quarters full. The first juice is called 'the virgin press'. I don't like to add any water, as I don't want to water it down."

The pulp is transferred in to the press. The plunger is made of white oak flooring, a very hard wood, that is necessary because it takes lots of pressure to excrete the apple juice. There is a 4 x 6 for the top for strength. He adds balance pieces of wood to gain height so the 12 ton jack will fit under the angled brace, then pumps that by hand to begin the flow of the golden liquid, using a piece of rain gutter to catch it and make the transition into a bucket below.

"Sometimes I run around and do other stuff for an hour and then come back and press some more. Press, press, press!" he says.

Jeff talked about last year's crop and the production they did on a grand scale, making some 136 gallons of cider. Some was made into wine, using a champagne yeast, and some became apple cider vinegar (by neglect they said), which they store in the basement. Sometimes he adds cloves and ginger to the juice.

"I tried storing some of it in beer bottles, but it still had yeast in it, and a lot of them exploded!"

"We really had a bumper crop last year. This year there are a lot less. Some of the trees had no apples. Some were just exhausted," Jeff says.

"I like the wine better than cider," Angie said.

Some questions asked:
What about bruised apples?

"I leave in bruised ones, as you can see they turn brown by oxidation very soon after they are turned into pulp."

Herbert George Wells (more commonly known as H.G. Wells) was a popular English author in the early 1900's. On Monday, 9/23/2019, around 4:50pm, a male was located in a swampy, wooded area by rescuers. The man, Wilmar Hanks, age 46 of Ogema, MN had gone out on Friday, 9/20/19, along with another individual, to harvest wild rice. Hanks was reported to have separated from his friend on Saturday, 9/21/19. Rescuers were notified by Hanks' family members on Sunday, 9/22/19 at 5:15pm, that Hanks had not returned from ricing and they were concerned for his safety.



The Clearwater County Sheriff's Office, White Earth Tribal Police Department, and the White Earth Conservation Department began an immediate search for Hanks. A helicopter from the Minnesota State Patrol came to the area to fly overhead to assist in the search. The Becker County Sheriff's Office assisted with their drone, and the Detroit Lakes Fire Department assisted in bringing an air boat. As the search continued into the late hours of the night, it was decided that search efforts would be suspended until daylight.

Search efforts resumed the next morning on Mon-

day 9/23/2019. Another aerial search was performed by the Minnesota State Patrol.

A search team consisting of members of the Clearwater County Sheriff's Office and White Earth Forestry were able to make a path to the swamp through the woods on ATVs and forestry equipment. The team then did a foot search through the swamp and woods, and were able to locate Hanks. Hanks was in stable condition, and was able to walk to a rescue vehicle, where he was transported out to a waiting ambulance to be evaluated. Hanks was transported to Sanford Bagley Medical Center for a full examination after his prolonged stay in the woods and swamp.

Public Safety agencies assisting in this rescue included the Clearwater County Sheriff's Office, White Earth Tribal Police Department, White Earth Conservation, White Earth Forestry/Fire, Becker County Sheriff's Office, Detroit Lakes Fire Department, Minnesota State Patrol Aviation Section, Polk County Sheriff's Office, White Earth Emergency Management, Clearwater County Emergency Management, Bagley Fire Department, and Sanford Bagley Ambulance.

Ask a Trooper

Question: The new hands-free law, does that

apply to tractors, lawn mowers and UTV's?

Answer: The hands-free law applies to all motor vehicles. A motor vehicle would include tractors and lawn mowers on a street or highway. The hands free law would not apply if someone was in a ditch or on private property. The UTV is not considered a motor vehicle, so they are not allowed on any state or federal roadway no matter how they are licensed.

UTVs are allowed on certain county and township roads if licensed properly. In that case, the hands-free law would apply.

In 12 out of 15 states with hands-free laws, traffic fatalities have decreased by an average of 15 percent. This law will protect motorists on Minnesota roads by reducing the distractions for drivers.

The first ticket for violation of the new law is \$50 plus court fees and the second and later tickets are \$275 plus court fees.

This summer when I was heading off to tractor shows I had the opportunity to see a lot of different tractors. Of course

there is nearly always a lot of John Deeres, Farmalls, Allis Chalmers, Case. But, you don't always see a Silver King!

The Fate-Root-Heath Company of Plymouth, Ohio, began to manufacture tractors in 1933. There first tractor was the three wheeled 10-20, with a 20 hp

Hercules engine. Silver King tractors were among the first to have an electrical starting system. With an easy to repair reputation they gained some popularity. In 1934, they came out with the 4 wheel design. they reportedly had a road speed of 45 miles per hour!! Many of these 4 wheeled R38 tractors came with a sickle mower and were sold to highway departments for mowing ditches.

I had never seen a Silver King tractor until I began watching the Dupont Classic Tractor videos that they began to make in the late 1980's and early 1990's. I remember hearing that a sales manager from another tractor company said that Silver King had the best made and poorest sold tractor on the market! I sure wish I had one in my line up!!

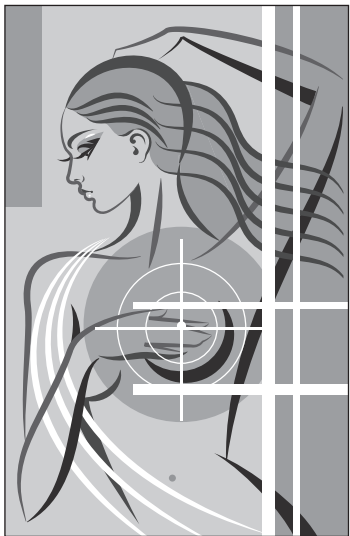

Breast cancer signs and symptoms

Breast cancer is a formidable foe. According to the World Health Organization, an estimated 627,000 women lost their lives to breast cancer in 2018. But women are not helpless in the fight against breast cancer, as the WHO notes early detection is critical and could potentially save thousands of lives each year.

A proactive approach is a key component of protecting oneself against breast cancer. While the National Breast Cancer Foundation, Inc.® notes that many breast cancer symptoms are invisible and not noticeable without a professional cancer screening, women can keep an eye out for certain signs of breast cancer they might be able to detect on their own. Monthly self-exams can help women more easily identify changes in their breasts. During such self-exams, women can look for the following signs and symptoms and are advised to report any abnormalities they discover to their physicians immediately.

Changes in how the breast or nipple feels: The NBCF says nipple tenderness or a lump or thickening in or near the breast



or underarm could indicate the presence of breast cancer. Some women may notice changes in the skin texture or an enlargement of the pores in the skin of their breast. In many instances, skin texture has been described as being similar to the texture of an orange peel. Lumps in the breast also may indicate breast cancer, though not all lumps are cancerous.

Change in appearance of the breast or nipple: Unex-

plained changes in the size or shape of the breast; dimpling anywhere on the breast; unexplained swelling or shrinking of the breast, particularly when the shrinking or swelling is exclusive to one side only; and a nipple that is turned slightly inward or inverted are some signs and symptoms of breast cancer that can affect the appearance of the breast or nipple. It is common for women's breasts to be asymmetrical, but sudden asymmetry should be brought to the attention of a physician.

Discharge from the nipple: The NBCF notes that any discharge from the nipple, but particularly a clear or bloody discharge, could be a sign of breast cancer. The NBCF also advises women that a milky discharge when they are not breastfeeding is not linked to breast cancer but should be discussed with a physician.

Learning to recognize the signs and symptoms of breast cancer can increase the likelihood of early diagnosis, which greatly improves women's chances of surviving this disease.

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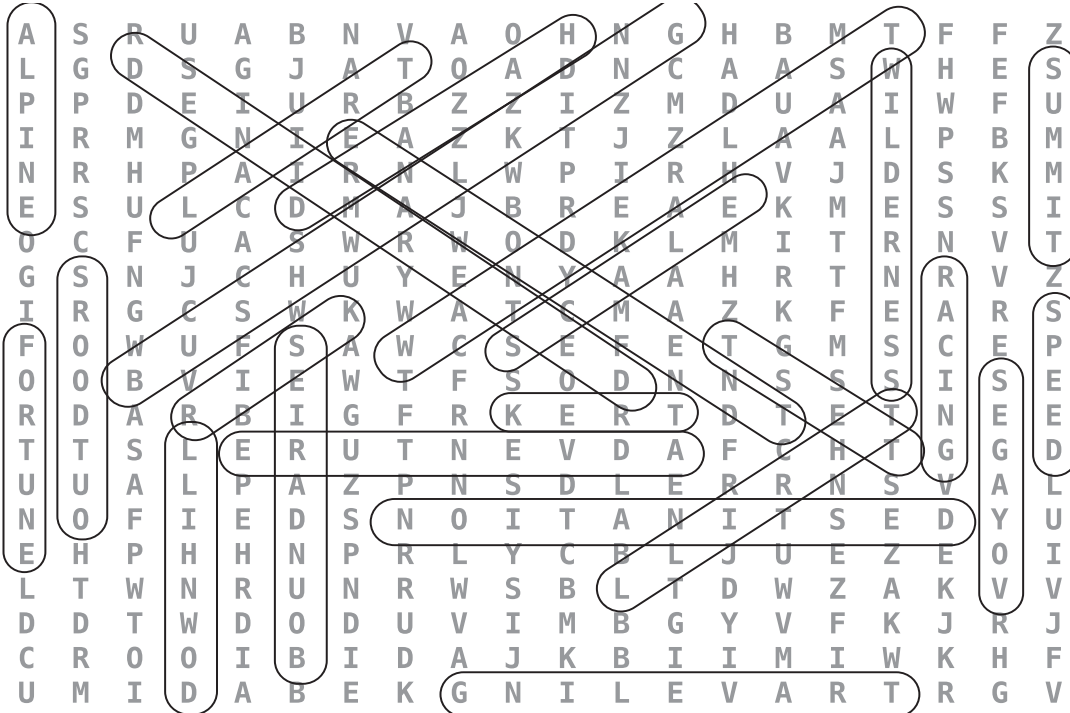
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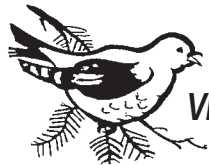
