Winter Hazard Awareness Week Nov. 4th-8th, 2019

The Polk County Sheriff's Office - Emergency Management Division is participating in the state-wide Winter Hazard Awareness Week campaign, which will take place November 4th - 8th, 2019. Winter Hazard Awareness Week is promoted by the Minnesota Department of Public Safety's Division of Homeland Security Emergency Management. This week allows Minnesotans an opportunity to familiarize themselves with the hazards we face each winter season. These hazards include dangers from winter weather, dangers from heating sources, and ventilation issues, just to name a few.

Each day of the week has a hazard topic.

Monday is Winter Weather Overview. Minnesota experiences a vast variety of inclement weather conditions during the winter months. In Polk County we are especially prone to experiencing brutal cold, heavy snowfall, and extreme winds. A number of different watches, warnings, and advisories are issued during the winter season. Winter Weather Advisories are issued when winter weather will cause travel difficulties. Winter Storm Warnings are issued for heavy snowfall, or the combination of dangerous blowing and drifting snow. A combination of blowing or falling snow, cold temperatures, and windy conditions can prompt a blizzard warning. Polk County is covered by the National Weather Service's Grand Forks Office. You can get additional weather information by visiting their website at: www.weather.gov/gf.

Tuesday's topic addresses Outdoor Winter Safety. Whether you are out enjoying the snow, or forced to work in it, it is important to dress adequately. During brutally cold weather exposure to the elements can lead to hypothermia

or frostbite. It is also important to consider the dangers of venturing onto thin ice. Remember that there should be at least four inches of fresh, clear ice before attempting to walk onto a frozen body of water.

Wednesday's topic addresses Winter Fire Safety. During the winter season there is usually an increase of structure fires. Reasons for the increase in structural fires includes holiday lights, holiday displays, and using alternative heating sources. To help prevent fires, keep decorations at least three feet from heating sources, and remember to check your furnace and chimney's to ensure they are operating properly.

Thursday's topic addresses Indoor Winter Safety. Some common indoor safety concerns that occur during the winter are monitoring carbon monoxide levels, managing moisture conditions to prevent mold and mildew growth, and minimizing chemical and environmental exposure.

Friday's topic covers Winter Driving. It is important to ensure that your vehicle has been serviced and is ready to take on the cold weather. A winter survival kit included in your vehicle could be the difference between life and death, in some situations. A winter survival kit should include a bag/container to store food and water, a flashlight, candles, matches, a blanket, and a distress sign to display in the window of your vehicle.

Fire results in death

On October 24, 2019 at 6:35 pm, a call came into the Clearwater County Sheriff's Office regarding a house fire in the City of Shevlin. A Clearwater County Deputy along with the Shevlin Fire Department responded and found the house on Roosevelt Street burning. Fire departments from Bagley and Solway were called to assist. The body of a 36-year-old male was found deceased inside the house. Information gathered indicates that the victim, Michael William Norgaard of Shevlin, had come home and discovered the house full of smoke. He called his sister to call 911 and said he was going inside to get his dogs out. The State Fire Marshall's Office was called to the scene to investigate, however, no cause of the fire is available at this time. No foul play is suspected in the fire. An autopsy is scheduled for today at UND Forensic Pathology in Grand Forks. The case remains under investigation by the Clearwater County Sheriff's Office and the State Fire Marshall.

Man found deceased in lake

On 10-23-19 at approximately 1622 hours the Polk County Sheriff's Office, Mentor Fire and Rescue, and County EMS responded to a report of a male face down in the lake at 34433 140th Ave SE. Steven Wayne Sveningsson (69) was pronounced deceased after resuscitation efforts by first responders failed. Autopsy pending, however no criminal activity is suspected. No further information is being released at this time.

Escapee apprehended

On 10-25-19 at approximately 1145 hours a Federal Prisoner (Fabian Wayne English, 33) escaped during a medical appointment at Riverview Hospital in Crookston. During the escape English stole a pickup and crashed it into the river. A short time later English was apprehended. There is no danger to the public. The Polk County Sheriff's Office and Crookston Police Department are investigating. This case is ongoing and no further information will be released at this time.

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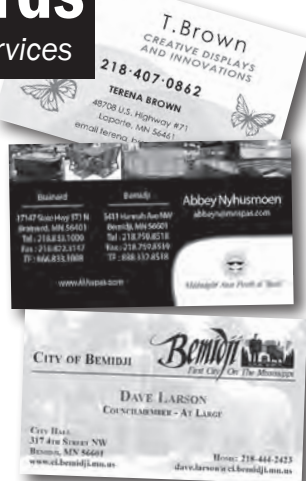
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Custodian I Facilities Management Department

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Pedestrian crashes, fatalities increase during fall months

ST. PAUL, Minn. – Shorter days and more hours of darkness this time of year contribute to an increase number of crashes between people driving and walking, according to the Minnesota Department of Transportation. As the days get shorter, motorists and pedestrians should use caution when driving and walking.

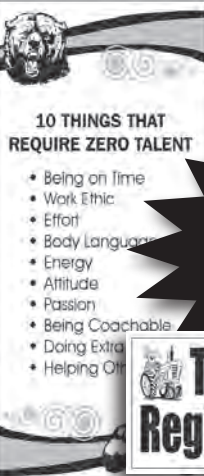
Motor vehicle crashes have killed 33 pedestrians so far this year. According to crash facts from the Department of Public Safety, 45 pedestrians died and 987 were injured in crashes with vehicles in 2018 and 42 pedestrian deaths and 1,053 injuries happened in 2017.

"It's more difficult to see people walking in the dark, so we see an increased risk for pedestrian crashes in the fall as daylight hours diminish," said Brian Sorenson, state traffic engineer. "Both drivers and walkers need to know and obey the laws to maximize safety. Remember, all of us walk at some point in our day."

The crosswalk law includes these highlights:

- People driving must stop for crossing pedestrians at marked crosswalks and at all intersections without crosswalks or stop lights.
- When a vehicle is stopped at an intersection, drivers of other vehicles approaching from the rear should never pass the stopped vehicle.
- Drivers should scan the road and sides of the road ahead for pedestrians.
- Drivers stopped for pedestrians can proceed once the pedestrian has completely crossed the lane in front of their stopped vehicle.
- People driving and walking should avoid distractions and dangerous behavior.
- People walking should obey traffic signs and signals at all intersections that have them.
- Pedestrians shouldn't enter a crosswalk if a vehicle is approaching and it is impossible for the driver to stop.

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
