First responders arrived on scene and located the victim, Bryce Brannan (19). Brannan was later transported by Crookston Area Ambulance to Altru Grand Forks for non-life threatening injuries. The Minnesota DNR will be investigating the incident further and no other information will be released at this time.

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Cody Landus, Oklee resident in critical condition

At approximately 16:30 on November 8, 2021, the Red Lake County Sheriff's Office received a report of a shooting outside of a residence on Elm Street in Oklee. Red Lake County Law Enforcement and the Oklee Ambulance responded to the scene. The victim, Cody Eldene Landrus, was transported from the scene by the Oklee Ambulance. Mr. Landrus had a single gunshot wound to his head. He was taken to Essentia Hospital in Fosston and then transferred to Fargo, ND where he remains in critical condition.

The suspect, Oliver John Berhow (27) of Fertile, was transported from the scene by the Thief River Falls Ambulance and was taken to the Sanford ER in Thief River Falls. He was treated for a head injury and was later released to Red Lake County law enforcement. He was taken to the jail in Crookston and booked for 2nd Degree Assault. Mr. Landrus and Mr. Berhow were acquaintances and the case is remains under investigation.

The victim of the shooting that occurred in Oklee on November 8th, Cody Eldene Landrus (31) of Oklee, remains in critical condition at Essentia Hospital in Fargo.

The suspected shooter, Oliver John Berhow (27) of Fertile, appeared in District Court on November 10, 2021 in Red Lake Falls to face a felony 2nd Degree Assault Charge. On this initial appearance, the Court set bail at \$800,000 without conditions and \$50,000 with conditions. Mr. Berhow remains in custody.

Cody Eldene Landrus, 31, was shot above his eye and was airlifted to a Fargo, N.D., hospital. The complaint indicated that, as of Tuesday, November 9th, he had been placed in a medically-induced coma.

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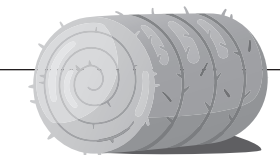

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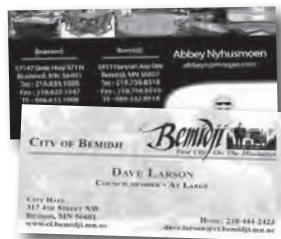
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Theology in the Trenches

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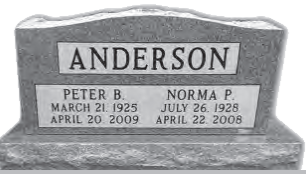

Makes one 12-ounce beverage

1 fluid ounce coffee or 1 shot espresso, such as Starbucks Christ-mas Blend or Starbucks Espresso Roast Coffee
