Vibra Hospital of Fargo is a critical care hospital, a type of specialty hospital that is designed to address the extended hospitalization needs of patients with complex medical issues.

Dorothy Walton, 59, is a home health nurse. In early December, she contracted CO-

VID-19 and was admitted to a local hospital. Unfortunately, Dorothy's condition deteriorated, requiring a transfer to a hospital in Fargo. There, she was intubated and ventilated due to respiratory distress. Dorothy also required nutritional support via a tube in her abdomen.

When Dorothy experienced respiratory failure, palliative care was suggested to her family. But instead, they chose to rely on their faith and prayers. Forty days after Dorothy's hospitalization, a miracle happened, and she made a tremendous turnaround. She weaned off the ventilator and improved significantly. Approximately

two months after her initial hospitalization, Dorothy transferred to Vibra Hospital of Fargo.

Though she made significant progress, Dorothy still had a long road ahead when she arrived at Vibra. Dorothy required respiratory support via a tracheostomy tube, nutritional support, and IV antibiotics for pneumonia upon admission. In addition, due to critical illness myopathy and neuropathy, she needed extensive physical, occupational, and speech therapies.

Dorothy continued to make rapid progress at Vibra, where her tracheostomy was removed. During her stay, she worked hard with physical and occupational therapies. She also made great strides with speech therapy, allowing her to progress to an oral diet.

Before long, Dorothy discharged to a facility closer to her home where she could focus on gaining more strength through therapy. She credits her improvement to her faith, prayers, and the support of her family while recovering at Vibra.

"My caregivers were excellent, and everyone treated me with dignity and respect," Dorothy said.

## Federal Funding for Local Projects

U.S. Senators Amy Klobuchar (D-MN) and Tina Smith (D-MN) announced that they have secured significant federal funding for local projects benefiting Northwest Minnesota. This funding will help boost local communities through a wide range of projects including major investments in the Thief River Falls Regional Airport, higher education for Minnesota's veterans and service members, wastewater treatment facility improvements, roadway infrastructure, childcare investments and more.

Funding secured by Klobuchar and Smith will help further the following priorities:

- Strengthen childcare facility infrastructure

\$418,000 will go towards remodeling a high-quality building that has been donated to Prairie Pines Childcare Center in Fosston. The building is in excellent condition, but needs significant interior remodeling to provide childcare services

and meet guidelines of the Department of Human Services.

"As economic development director in Fosston, I have seen the importance of expanding childcare access and capacity," said Michelle Landsverk, Economic Development Director of the Fosston Economic Development Authority. "People who do not have childcare can't fully engage with the workforce. Employers who can't fill open positions can't thrive. Maybe most important of all, opening Prairie Pines Childcare Center means that we will be able to provide excellent care to young children and give them a strong foundation for success in school and in life. We've been working hard to increase childcare capacity in Fosston for the last few years. The award to Prairie Pines Childcare Center will allow us to open without debt and insure long-term sustainability of the center. We are beyond thankful to Senator Smith and Senator Klobuchar for champi-

oning our project."

- Upgrade the Thief River Falls Regional Airport

\$7.5 million to ensure a safe and reliable operation for the largest aircraft operating at the airport. The new cargo area expansion will allow light maintenance to occur indoors and allow loading and unloading operations to occur in a safe, warm environment. Federal funds will be used to match the State of Minnesota's contribution to pre-design, design, construct, furnish, and equip an air cargo hangar.

- Rehabilitate and expand wastewater treatment facility in Bemidji

\$4.4 million to fund much needed repairs at the Wastewater Treatment Facility in the City of Bemidji. The funding will also allow the facility to expand from its two clarifiers to three, which will ensure that

when one is out (for regular maintenance or repairs), the facility is able to meet demand.

• Construct a fire hall in Dilworth

\$975,000 to support the demolition and construction of a fire hall serving two cities, three rural townships, and providing mutual aid to all other rural Clay County cities.

• Reconstruct and upgrade highway infrastructure in Moorhead

\$500,000 for full reconstruction of the roadway in the City of Moorhead, including “complete street” and lane reduction modifications. The project will add safety enhancements and create opportunities for multimodal transportation. The planned reconstruction would make road diet elements permanent, construct sidewalks to be more accessible for pedestrians, and create wide outside lanes to incorporate bicycle traffic. The reconstruction will also address alignment issues with 4th Street and set the stage for commercial reinvestment in Moorhead’s downtown corridor.

• Expand workforce development opportunities

\$1.9 million to Alexandria Technical & Community College to support the pilot platform for a Global Military Learning Network. This program will reduce the time and cost for military service members to earn a degree by awarding credit for military learning and occupational experiences, streamlining military admissions processes, developing a secure military-friendly enrollment portal, eliminating the cost of remedial coursework, and increasing the number of military graduates available to meet workforce needs.

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## Northland Awards Fall 2021 Foundation Scholarships

Northland Community & Technical College proudly announces the recipients of the fall 2021 Northland Community & Technical College Foundation scholarships. ### Ask a Trooper

**t i o n:** With the warmer weather and snow melt-

ing I'm getting spring fever and purchased an old trailer to haul my motorcycle around, are brakes required on it?

**Answer:** Brakes are required on all trailers with a gross weight of 3,000 pounds or more. Trailers manufactured after June 30, 1988, with a gross weight of 3,000 pounds or more require brakes installed on all wheels.

Every trailer with a gross weight of more than 3,000 pounds shall also be equipped with a breakaway brake device which will automatically apply

and hold the brakes should the trailer accidentally become detached from the towing unit.

Trailers manufactured prior to July 1, 1988 that are equipped with three or more axles are not required to have brakes on the front axle, provided the brakes on all other wheels meet the performance standards prescribed by law.

The manufacturers of many new vehicles equipped with anti-lock brake systems require any towed unit be equipped with electric brakes and the towing vehicle be equipped with an electronic brake controller.

It's also important to check the brakes on your personal vehicle every three months. Too often, vehicle owners put off

simple maintenance until it's too late. Deteriorating brakes can create longer stopping distances, ultimately leading to a crash. Do your part to maintain your vehicle to avoid a crash.

You can avoid a ticket — and a crash — if you simply buckle up, drive at safe speeds, pay attention and always drive sober. Help us drive Minnesota Toward Zero Deaths.

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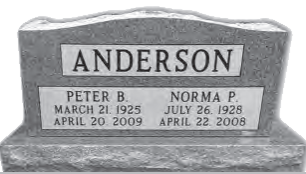

Mireille Genadry was born in Cairo, Egypt to a family of Lebanese expatriates who merchandised and manufactured cotton fabric. She grew up speaking French to her parents and Arabic to her classmates while spending summers on the beaches of Alexandria, Egypt. At the age of 8 her family was forced to sell all their assets at a steep discount and flee Egypt to avoid the discriminatory policies of Gamal Nasser. She remembers overhearing a customs officer telling her father that at 8 she was old enough to be on her own in Cairo so he would not allow her to leave with the family. As is usually the case in corrupt and feckless regimes, a generous payment was made to the officer and his superiors which convinced them to give approval to her departure. She boarded with her mother and siblings, but her father had to stay behind with the very real risk that he would never be allowed to leave Egypt. This was a sacrifice he was willing to make so his family could live in a just country. Her clever father found a way to join the family in Beirut where Mireille was learning her third language the hard way having been enrolled in the Italian School (where all instruction was in Italian). The political winds were changing in Lebanon with civil war on the horizon, so her father's cousin, General Francois Genadry advised the family to move elsewhere.

Mireille started school in New York one grade behind her level due to her unfamiliarity with the English language. She vividly remembered being openly ridiculed by a teacher and her classmates for being an ignorant person. In short order she was moved up two grade levels and ambitiously completed her school requirements graduating from St. Agnes High School at the age of 16. She decided to attend Hofstra University so the family moved to Garden City, Long Island where Mireille could live at home while attending college. Mireille once again diligently applied herself to her studies and graduated from Hofstra at the age of 19.

Mireille had a career in

international banking at European American Bank covering Eastern Europe and the Middle East. She signed her communiques as "M. Genadry" because many in these areas would not deal with her if they knew she was a woman. We kept her old magnetic nameplate on the refrigerator. One day it let loose and fell causing our very young son Ben to exclaim "Mom, the M. Genadry bonked me on the head!"

Mireille left the bank to increase her knowledge of business by studying for an MBA degree at Columbia University in New York. She financed her education with her own savings, earned her degree and met her future husband, David Beito.

She began a career in consulting at KPMG Peat Marwick, but love won over career and upon her marriage in 1989, she moved to her current family home in Thief River Falls. She continued doing consulting projects in New York and Thief River Falls and then devoted her time and energy to her family and especially her children, Ben and Kim.

While her family was her priority, she never lost her thirst for knowledge and skills. She received her certification in Civil and Employment Mediation and over the last two and a half years had received certificates in 22 courses in business analytics, the use of IT to conduct analytics, digital transformation and a capstone course in quantum computing and its effects on all these corporate processes which she completed in February of 2022.

She was a faithful Christian and was true to her Catholic faith. She had recited the rosary daily for over 20 years. She was the primary care giver for her mother and her sister Sonia, moving them from New York to a Florida Care Center where she made sure their every need was provided for.

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## Signs of winter lawn damage

Snow-covered lawns can be pretty, but heavy snowfall can contribute to winter lawn damage.

Mother Nature can be harsh on a lawn, and it's up to homeowners to nurse their lawns back to health after they endure the elements. That's often the case when winter ends and homeowners uncover signs of damage to their lawns.

Homeowners cannot begin to repair winter lawn damage until they learn to identify it, and the following are some telltale signs that winter took a harsh toll on a landscape.

• **Wilted grass:** Many things can cause grass to wilt over the course of winter, so homeowners may have to put on their sleuth's cap to determine why grass that was healthy as recently as late fall is now wilted as the spring bloom begins. Grass that's adjacent to walkways and driveways might have wilted due to the application of de-icing solutions. Such products can prevent the formation of ice on driveways and walkways. However, when they're tracked onto the grass by people or animals or blown there by winter winds, grass can wilt. A deep watering in spring can flush any lingering solution from the lawn. In future winters, homeowners can be as careful as possible when applying de-icing solutions, making a concerted effort to avoid spreading any onto the grass and limited applications to areas of the driveway and walkways that are not close to the grass.

• **Brown patches:** The National Association of Land-

scape Professionals notes that brown patches in a lawn often develop after heavy snowfall. Such patches tend to develop where large piles of shoveled snow were deposited, so homeowners can inspect alongside driveways and walkways. The NALP advises homeowners to rake away part of the brown patches first. If green tissue is emerging beneath, then the lawn will likely be fine in due time. However, if the area beneath is not green and surrounding areas are already turning green, homeowners may need to rake up dead tissue before applying topsoil to the affected spots. Once topsoil is spread, some grass seed can be spread and the grass should regain its green glory.

• **Gray or pink grass:** Another indicator of winter lawn damage linked to snow is gray or pink grass. The NALP reports that this is a byproduct of snow mold caused by lingering snow. Action may be unnecessary, as the NALP notes these circular patterns often go away on their own. If not, raking the affected areas might be enough to get the lawn on the road to recovery. If the issue continues to linger after raking, a topsoil application and subsequent seeding may be necessary.

These are three common signs of winter lawn damage in areas where snowfall is significant during the coldest months of the year. Homeowners concerned about their damaged lawns are urged to contact a local landscape professional to correct any issues that linger into spring.
