Gold Medal Rosemaler teaches class in Clearbrook

Norda Gonvick Rosemalers that meets every week in the Good Shepherd Church in Clearbrook had a special event last week. Ken Magnussen, a Gold Medal Rosemaler taught a 3-day "Old Rogaland Style" workshop for those who attended. Magnussen, who is of Norwegian and Danish decent, started in 1975 with a book that a friend had given him on rosemaling. That did not work and he went on to take classes in his hometown of Zumbrota. It took him until 2000 when he started winning ribbons at the national competition in Decorah, Iowa. He received Best in Show for a cabinet that he did. By 2003 he had won enough points to receive Gold Medal honors for his rosemaling.

Vesterheim awards Gold Medals to artists who have repeatedly won ribbons in the annual National Exhibition of Folk Art in the Norwegian Tradition. An artist earns a Gold Medal when they accumulate 8 points: blue-ribbon pieces earn three points, red-ribbon pieces earn two points, and white-ribbon pieces earn a single point.

Decorah is the location of the Vesterheim Norwegian-American Museum which includes historic buildings, a Folk Art School and library.

Magnussen is a graduate of the University of Minnesota and retired as a veterinarian. He said that after working with the Norda Gonvick group for three days he was ready to rest.

He has been teaching in several states besides Minnesota including North Dakota, South Dakota, Washington and California. The Norda Gonvick group received a grant provided by the Region 2 Arts Council through an appropriation from the Minnesota State Legislature to put on the workshop.

Area residents were invited to join them for a cup of coffee and some Scandinavian Goodies and to view some rosemaling. They displayed a variety of styles from the group and several items that Magnussen had completed.

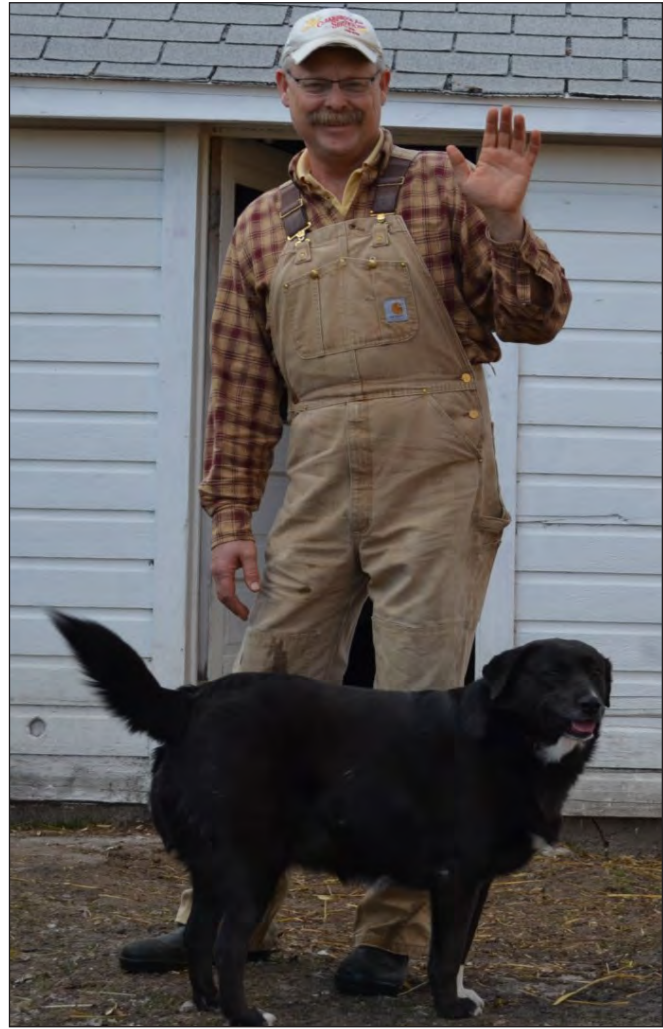
There will be drawings every hour (1:30 pm, 2:30 pm, and 3:30 pm) for various electronic items, tickets will be on sale during the benefit.

Copter shooting hearing held

A federal hearing was held in St. Paul for Carstie Clausen of rural Clearbrook. The charges were from an incident that happened August 8. Clausen was accused of opening fire on a helicopter as it passed over his property which was looking for a possible marijuana growing operation.

The hearing on Wednesday, October 5 where the U.S. District Court of Minnesota entered a not guilty plea on Clausen's behalf as he had refused to submit a plea.

Clausen requested to represent himself and he filed a motion to dismiss his charge saying the District Court should maintain jurisdiction over the crime.

The next day U.S. District Judge Richard Kyle recused himself from hearing the case and asked that it be reassigned.

Temporary off-highway vehicle trail closures begin in November

The Minnesota Department of Natural Resources will restrict recreational use of off-highway vehicles (OHVs) in some areas during the upcoming firearms deer hunting season. Vehicles affected by the restrictions include all-terrain vehicles (ATVs), off-highway motorcycles (OHMs) off-road vehicles (ORVs) and snowmobiles that are not being used in conjunction with deer hunting by a licensed deer hunter.

The restrictions, which apply to state forest trails and access routes but not to state forest roads, aim to protect recreational riders from potentially unsafe riding conditions and to minimize conflicts between

deer hunters and recreational riders who may inadvertently disturb them.

Licensed deer hunters may only use an OHV or snowmobile in restricted areas during the legal hunting season:

- Before legal shooting time.
- From 11 a.m. to 2 p.m.
- After legal shooting hours.

Effective dates of the recreational riding restrictions will be:

- Nov. 5-Nov. 20 for the northeastern Minnesota 100 series deer season.
- Nov. 5-Nov. 13 for the Minnesota 200 series deer season.

Because recreational OHV trails located in southeastern Minnesota close Nov. 1 each

year, no additional OHV riding restrictions are necessary in that part of the state.

While many recreational OHV riders have voluntarily opted not to ride forest trails during deer hunting and small-game seasons, recreational OHV riding has become a year-round sport for many. DNR officials remind everyone who visits Minnesota's state forests this fall to put safety first.

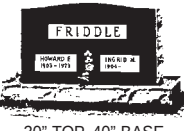
