Garden Valley delivers trick-or-treat bags to area students

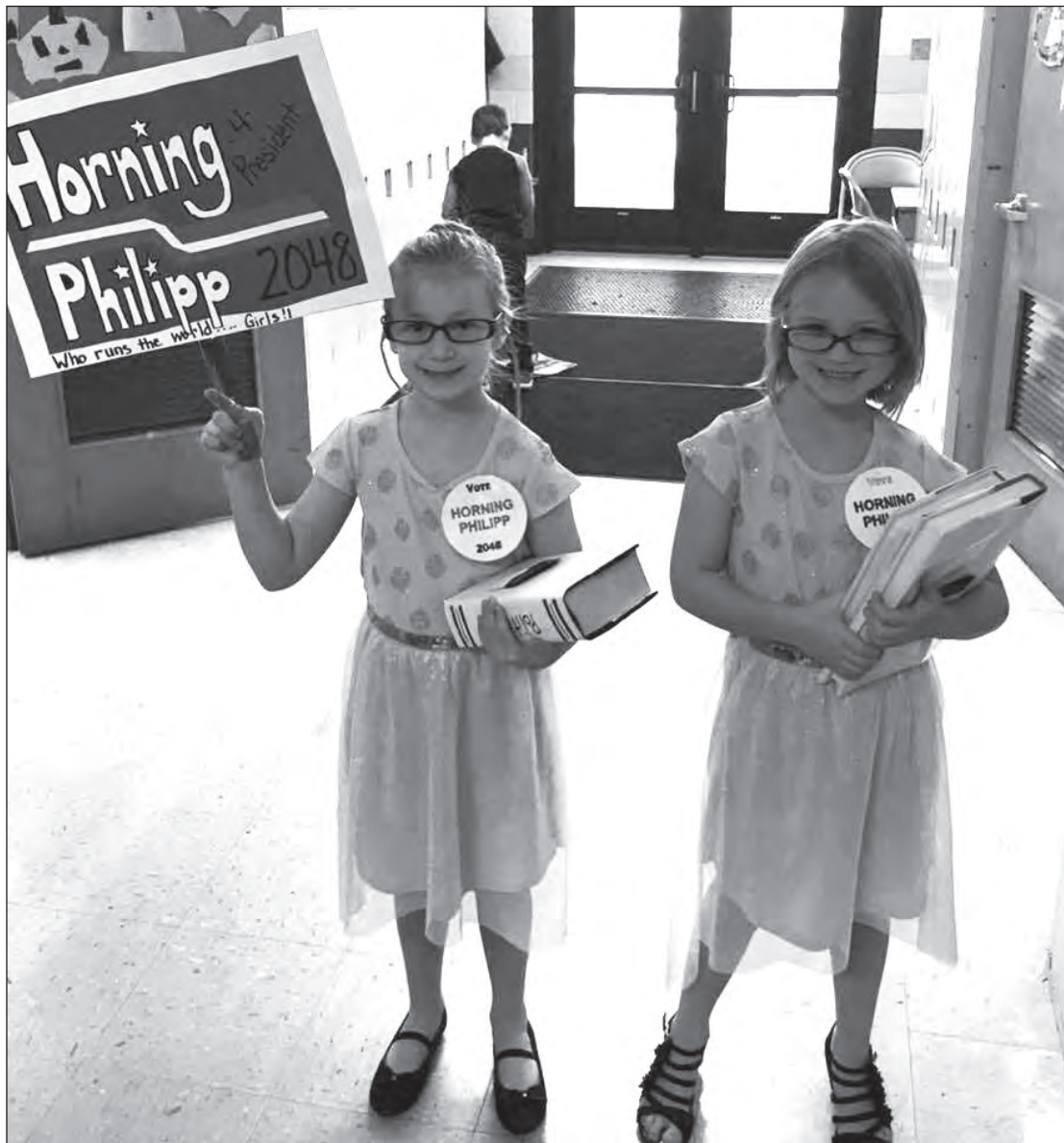

Lt. Governor Tina Smith Announces Six Weeks of Paid Parental Leave for State Employees

Lt. Governor Tina Smith today announced that up to six weeks of paid parental leave is now available to 32,000 state employees across Minnesota. This nation-leading effort from the Dayton-Smith Administration will save families around the state an average of \$6,200 in wages at a time when many parents need it most. It also gives parents the opportunity to spend time with their children as they learn, grow, and bond. Minnesota is only the fourth state in the nation to offer paid parental leave to its employees.

"I became a new mom in 1987. At the time, I ran my own business out of the house, and Archie worked long hours and traveled constantly. Two years later, we had another son. I was able to take time away from work for both babies," said Lt. Governor Tina Smith. "I don't know how we would have managed without this crucial time. Today's announcement means that more than 32,000 Minnesota state employee families will have that same opportunity. This is an important step, but we need to keep working so access to family and medical leave isn't determined by the luck of where parents work."

State employees previously could use accrued sick leave or purchase short-term disability insurance coverage to take paid time off following the birth or adoption of a child. As a result,

non-birth parents and newer employees with more limited incomes or sick time had fewer opportunities to bond with a new child. Providing six weeks of paid parental leave to state employees will expand the opportunity for paid bonding time to more than 32,000 Minnesotans across the state.

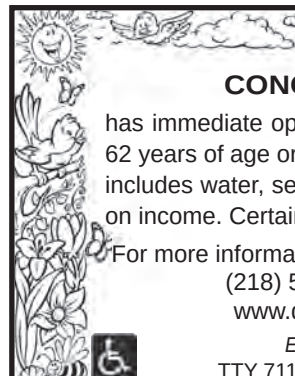

Question: I was wondering what the State Patrol uses to write on windows of vehicles when they are broke down alongside the road? It is usually orange in color. Is it a grease pencil or something else and where can I get one?

Answer: The State Patrol uses paint markers to help provide Troopers with a record of the date and time when a Trooper first observes an unattended or abandoned vehicle upon a highway. Marking the vehicle facilitates its removal in a timely manner, thereby expediting the safe, orderly flow of traffic.



The paint marker itself is a water based neon color. They can be purchased at most retail stores that deal in automotive or decorative type supplies, and also online.

More than 4,000 Motorists Took Dangerous Chances during Extra Seat Belt Enforcement

Most Minnesotans know the life-saving value of buckling up. For those who don’t, they received an unwelcome reminder during the extra seat belt enforcement campaign Oct. 14 – 30.

Enforcement Results

- Sheriff’s deputies, police officers and troopers from 312 law enforcement agencies issued 4,351 seat belt citations and 166 child seat citations.
- During the campaign a year ago, there were 5,550 seat belt citations and 128 child seat citations from 320 agencies.

A Deadly Choice

There were 28 traffic fatalities during the two-week campaign, and nineteen of those lives lost were people in vehicles:

- Nine were not wearing seat belts.
- Of those who were unbelted, their ages ranged from 16 to 71.
- Of the nine who weren’t wearing seat belts, eight were men and one was a woman.

Sad Stories, Painful Reminders

Among the crashes that happened during the extra enforcement:

- In Morrison County, a

pickup truck ran off the road and rolled over, ejecting and killing the unbelted driver and passenger.

- A car broadsided a pickup truck in an intersection in Pope County, killing the unbelted car passenger. The drivers wearing seat belts had minor or no injuries.

- A car crossed the median and was hit by another car in Dakota County. Three unbelted passengers in the same vehicle were ejected, killing one and seriously injuring the other two. Three people wearing seat belts had minor or no injuries (both drivers and one passenger).

Coordinated Effort

- The enhanced enforcement and education efforts are coordinated through the Minnesota Department of Public Safety Office of Traffic Safety (DPS-OTS) with overtime paid through federal funds received from the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA).

- The extra overtime shifts also resulted in a number of other arrests and citations for offenses including DWI, drug possession, speeding and texting-while-driving.

Every Seat, Every Time

Minnesota law requires all motorists to buckle up both in the front and back seat or be seated in the correct child restraint. Officers will stop and ticket unbelted drivers or passengers. Seat belts must be worn correctly — low and snug across the hips or thighs, and shoulder straps should never be tucked under an arm or behind the back.

Minnesota Child Car Seat Law and Steps

- In Minnesota, all children must be in a child restraint until they are 4’9” tall, or at least age 8, whichever comes first.
- Rear-facing child seats - Newborns to at least 1 year and 20 pounds; recommended up to age 2. It is safest to keep a child rear-facing as long as possible.
- Forward-facing seats - Age 2 until around age 4. It’s preferable to keep children in a harnessed restraint until they reach the maximum weight limit of the seat.
- Booster seats - Use after outgrowing a forward-facing harnessed restraint; it is the law to remain in a booster until 4’ 9” tall, or at least age 8, whichever comes first. It is

recommended that children stay in booster seats until the seat belt properly fits them. That means the belt lap is low on the hips and the shoulder belt is between their neck and shoulders.

- Seat belts - Use when children have outgrown a booster and the seat belt fits appropriately:

- o They can sit with their back against the vehicle seat and have their knees bent comfortably over the edge with their feet touching the floor.
- o The shoulder belt rests on their shoulder (not on their face or upper arm).
- o The lap portion of the belt is low on their hips.
- o They can ride comfortably in this position for the entire trip.

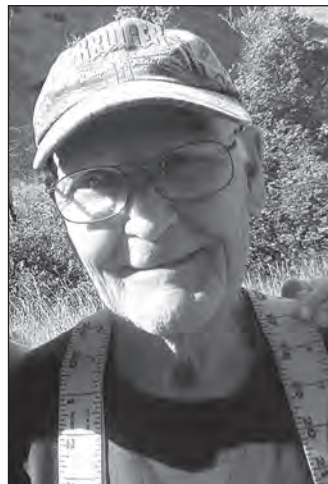
Martha enjoyed dancing, and she loved reading books, gardening, traveling, and baking.

Red Lake winter walleye regulations announced

Anglers fishing Upper Red Lake this winter will be able to keep three walleye of which only one may be longer than 17 inches, according to the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources.

The regulations, effective Thursday, Dec. 1, are the same regulations that were in place last winter.

"These regulations were very well accepted by anglers, and meet our harvest plan objectives by spreading harvest over a wide range of sizes and removing some of the surplus spawning stock," said Gary Barnard, Bemidji area fisheries supervisor with the DNR.

In fall assessment netting by the DNR and the Red Lake Band of Chippewa, walleye abundance was excellent with large numbers of fish from 12 to 20 inches.

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DNR announces art contest for state's first pollinator critical habitat license plate

Wildlife artists can submit entries for the critical habitat pollinator plate from Monday, Dec. 5 through 4 p.m. Monday, Dec. 12. Contest Rules, application and artist agreement forms will be available online next week on the critical habitat

"Pollinators such as butterflies and bees have been of concern in recent years due to many of the challenges that affect our native insects," said Crystal Boyd, DNR bee specialist. "These challenges include pesticide use, habitat loss, pathogens, parasites, climate change, invasive species, and other factors. A pollinator license plate is a great way for Minnesota motorists to express their concern and appreciation for our native insects."

The Minnesota Legislature created the critical habitat license plate program in 1995 to provide additional opportunity for Minnesotans to contribute toward conservation. Motorists who purchase a critical habitat plate pay a \$10 initial fee, plus a minimum annual contribution of \$30 to the Reinvest in Minnesota program. Every dollar generated through the sale of the license plate is matched with private donations of cash or land. The annual \$30 contribution is not tax deductible.
