Storm downs power lines, trees and dumps large amount of water

Early on Friday morning, June 29 a thunderstorm went through the area and caused considerable amount of damage. Power line crews from Clearwater Polk Electric, Wild Rice Electric and Beltrami Electric were working overtime to get power restored to area residents. Most were back on line except for several areas that were not up until Sunday afternoon.

Chain saws were heard in the area as roads were being cleared of fallen trees. Some Clover Township residents in Clearwater County could not even get out of their homes.

North of Kelliher, in Beltrami County, there was a report of an overturned aircraft.

Residents of McIntosh and Winger were the hardest hit in Polk county. A roof on a building had been blown off in McIntosh. The old school building had a very large tree down. There was a report of a house fire in McIntosh.

Winger had several lines down with a power pole tipped on it's side. The Memorial Park in Winger had large trees down.

The weather service reported that winds from 70 to 80 miles per hour went through the area.

Clearwater County Weed Specialist

Spring was a little late in coming this year. Then we got some late snow and rain to further delay many farmers from planting their crops. It is nice to see the corn and soybeans finally coming up. Thank goodness we have earlier maturing varieties available now. With the late spring came a delay in weed control also. Many farmers had to look at their chemical choices and in some cases make some changes. Luckily we have a lot of chemicals to choose from.

This same delay caused many homeowners to try some new chemical to control yard and garden weeds. Dandelions in many cases have gone to seed before they could be controlled. Once the weeds shows the white seed heads it is useless to apply chemicals, because you will only kill the rosettes of leaves at ground level. The plant has already produced the seed to grow at a later time.

Homeowners should consider a fall chemical application. Dandelions and many other weeds germinate during the summer and fall to produce seeds for the next year. In this case chemicals applied will kill the young plants and prevent seed production.

A good chemical to use in the fall is Forefront, which is a chemical mixture of Milestone and 2, 4-D. The 2, 4-D is a contact chemical that kills the weed rosettes on contact. The Milestone can carry over at ground level and kill any young weeds that germinate later. This product is available at most agricultural chemical businesses such as the co-ops and grain elevators. The recommended rate of application is 1.5 to 2 pints per acre. This chemical works on most species of thistles as well.
