Pumpkin Grower's News

Pumpkin Growers met recently- the upcoming 25th Big Pumpkin Contest and the Pumpkin Days activities were of course first on the agenda. Next was guest speaker, Robert Johnson of Robert Johnson Farms. Robert spoke on many issues of interest to pumpkin growers, Starting with soil

samples & the importance of organic matter, micro nutrients, zinc and calcium, etc. He discussed the use of root growth hormones and when questioned explained how he used root growth hormones on his different crops and how it could apply to competitive pumpkin growing. He also showed slides on an ongoing experiment with growth hormones & combinations of growth hormones at different stages of growth. (Robert definitely had everybody's attention, at this stage you could have heard a pin drop- later someone was heard to say, "He knows too much, it's a good thing that he isn't in the contest.")

The Question & Answer segment was highlighted by Robert's diagnoses of a white mold fungus in Tucker Johnson's pumpkin patch, with Robert's, Ag Scientist, Tim Swanson from CHS skypping in & explaining that ample moisture and warm weather was causing the fungus. Tim recommended headline of Priaxor Fungicide applied at 10 gal/acre. It was an outstanding presentation that applied very much to competitive pumpkin growing.

Every contestants mind was on the recent storm damage to competitors' pumpkin patches. This years' most favorite to do well, J.J. Solberg had heavy hail damage- "looked like it was mowed down by a machine gun." He had similar damage 2 years ago and still grew a 1,000 pound plus pumpkin.

Tucker Johnson hasn't reported in yet, but being on the Big Pumpkin Knob he always has wind problems & he was right in the center of the red zone before it hit J.J.'s. Bob Edevold hadn't recovered from transplant shock yet. (after 25 years of pumpkin growing, he should have known better) & then the hail storm hit. And put a million holes into any idea of a three-peat.

Al Danielson's best germination & early season growth year ever. He hasn't reported in, but he's well protected by buildings and wind breaks and is probably the new leader.

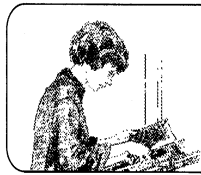

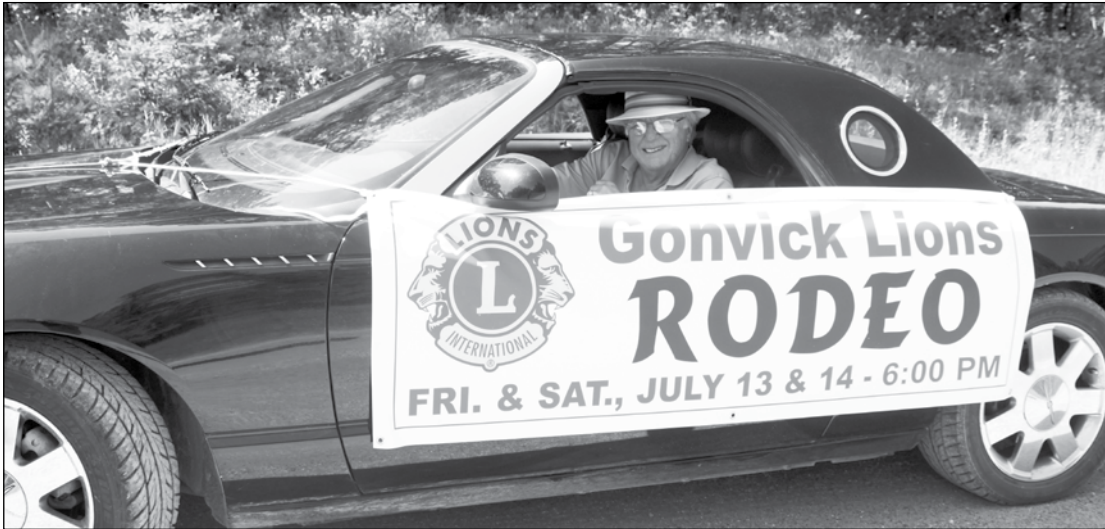
We received a newspaper renewal from Lila Ricke from Bagley. She put a note on the Uff Da card that said, "Love your Paper!" Thank you.
