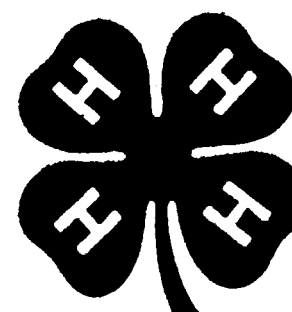
"Having meaningful relationships with a caring adult as a youth is invaluable. To know that someone cares about them and has a vested interest in their success, really allows our kids to flourish and grow in so many ways. Without the support I received through 4-H, I wouldn't be the person that I am today," said Kayla Nyegaard, Extension Educator 4-H Youth Development, Clearwater County. "Our 4-H clubs do so much in our community as well. Just last weekend, the

Jack Pine Pals 4-H Club picked ditches along highway 2. Leon Ramblers 4-H Club maintains a flowerbed and built benches for the city of Clearbrook. These kids are making a huge difference and becoming better people in the process."

Clearwater County 4-Hers are involved in MANY project areas. Our Sheep Project has greatly expanded in recent years, with our youth improving their flocks in the process. We had over 100 sheep projects at the county fair this year with four advancing to the Minnesota State Fair. At the State Fair, three Clearwater County Sheep exhibitors earned Purple Ribbons on their projects. That's a huge achievement!

One of our newest projects is the Engineering Design Challenge. In this project, youth must come up with an elaborate plan to accomplish a simple task. Along with their coach, they implement the elements of engineering to design their machine. Clearwater County had four youth compete at the State Engineering Design Challenge in early August this year.

In Clearwater County, more than 130 4-H youth and 40 volunteers from the community



are involved in 4-H. There is something for everyone in this program! We would love to have you involved.

One of the most anticipated events of National 4-H Week every year is 4-H National Youth Science Day, which sees hundreds of thousands of youth across the nation taking part in the world's largest youth-led STEM challenge. The exciting theme for this year's challenge is Game Changers, which will run throughout October. Developed by Google and West Virginia University Extension Service, Game Changers will teach kids coding skills through fun exercises including gaming, puzzles and physical activity.

"Virtual Dementia Tour" was an "eye-opening" experience for the community members who participated. Reactions ran through the gamete of feelings from frustration to anger to laughter.

The person who felt angry was angry because she couldn't do anything. Another said, "I feel like I'm a leader, but I just wanted to hold someone's hand and follow." Another reached a conclusion that how one reacts to the symptoms of dementia may depend on how you were raised, your background, and your life's work.

Created for anyone seeking to understand the physical and mental challenges of those suffering from dementia, this tool allows you to experience its effects. 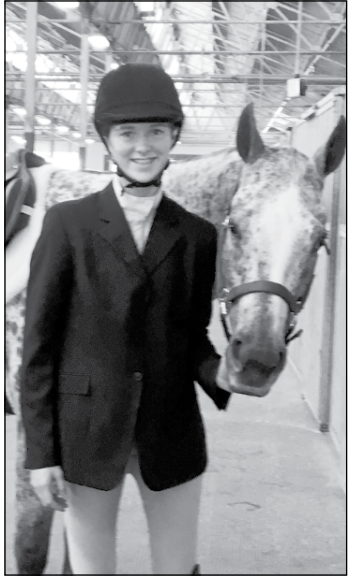

VA E-HEALTH RECORD MODERNIZATION: VA launches groundbreaking training program to fully leverage new electronic health record solution September 16, 2019, 11:03:00 AM. The U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) recently launched an innovative new training program to support its electronic health record modernization (EHRM) effort that, as of Sept. 12, had selected 76 trainees who have begun projects that address real-world VA health care challenges. Leveraging the experiences of the Department of Defense's (DOD) current EHR rollout, VA developed the VA Innovative Technology Advancement Lab (VITAL) training program, recognizing the importance of providing advanced training to selected end users who will support continuous performance improvement. "VA established VITAL to specially train staff who can identify possible challenges and work across the entire VA organization to make improvements," said VA Secretary Robert Wilkie. "VITAL is an important component in our larger training strategy, which will help ensure efficient and timely user adoption of the modernized EHR system." The new EHR solution will be the single source of Veteran health information. Its advancements will allow users who solve a problem at one facility to share the solution with other facilities in near real-time. The VITAL program, a 12-18-month training series, develops both the technical and supporting change management skills necessary to drive greater efficiency and effectiveness in all aspects of Veteran health care. VA identified key clinical and frontline staff who require advanced training to ensure smooth EHR modernization implementation, enhance functionality and support continuous performance improvement. In May 2018, VA awarded Cerner Corp. a contract to replace the department's legacy patient record systems with the commercial-off-the-shelf solution currently being deployed by DOD. A single interoperable solution across VA and DOD will facilitate the secure transfer of active-duty service members' health data as they transition to Veteran status. This modernization effort will create a lifetime of seamless care for service members and Veterans.
