10:00 am Judy Engebretson, Finger Painting & Color Theory Weekend Workshop with Alice Blessing

Headwaters Music & Arts will host a two-day finger painting and color theory course lead by by local artist and teacher, Alice Blessing the weekend of March 27th. Participants will be introduced to color theory and finger painting techniques in this hands-on painting class as each student creates a large painting of a bird to take home. Participants will learn to mix the whole spectrum using the primary colors, as well as how white and black affect hues and mixtures. Throughout the workshops, participants will learn basic ideas and theories about art, painting, materials, and composition. The goal is to enjoy painting and have a lot of fun.

Alice is known for her finger-painted portraits of people and animals. She has taught Painting, Drawing, and Color Theory classes at Bemidji State University. Over the past year she has been working on her newest series of portraits about marginalized young girls in northern Minnesota, a series made possible by a grant from Region 2 Arts Council, with funding from the McKnight Foundation. She says, "I'm deliberately using bold, intense colors this year while knowing that they have always been an important part of my paintings, my style, and my message. However, my experience as a teacher has taught me that everybody has unique reactions to color, and the best thing I can do is help people identify the colors that make them feel strong, or happy, or relaxed. I have developed this workshop to produce a lively yet realistic painting that is easily adjustable to individuals' color preferences."

The workshop is for ages 16-adult and will be held 6-9 pm Friday March 27th and 10 am - 2:30 pm Saturday, March 28th with a half-hour lunch break at noon on Saturday. All supplies are provided but participants will need to plan their own meals. There are limited spots available so folks are asked to register by March 20th. The cost to attend is \$50/participant with scholarships available. Folks can register by calling 218.444.5606 or online at Headwaters website.

Elementary Art at Bagley Public Library

The Bagley Elementary School's Sixth Grade Art is on display at the Bagley Public Library's Display Case from Tuesday, February 25, 2020 through March 31, 2020.

The students created their own cardboard looms. They needed to measure accurately, cut their notches and warp their loom. From there, students were able to choose the color of the yarn that they wanted to weave with. This project took the 6th graders about two months to complete.

The 6th graders created woven pouches. They had the choice of weaving their loom from bottom to top on both sides or stopping halfway and only going to the top on one side. Those that stopped partway created a lid to their woven pouch. Many of the students chose colors that connected to things that they were interested in. Some made their pouches with others in mind.

The students practice various art forms and materials throughout the year. We made these weavings to practice making art that was not only decorative but also functional.

Pickleball Fun in Gonvick

Pickleball started as a six-week class at the Clear Water Life Center in Gonvick but quickly became an addiction for players who continue to meet to play each week.

While pickleball has been around since the 1960's, not everyone has had the opportunity to become familiar with the sport. Pickleball is similar to badminton and tennis. It is played on a court with a net. A plastic ball, similar to a wiffle ball, is hit across the net with a paddle. The game can be played by singles or doubles. Pickleball is relatively easy to learn, making it popular with people of all ages.

The pickleball class was offered this past September to introduce the sport to local residents. Because pickleball has been so popular, the game continues to be played each Monday from 11:00 to 12:00 p.m. While Monday is the officially scheduled game time, some of the players also meet at the Life Center at the same time

on Wednesdays and Fridays. The gym is open to walkers during these same times.

The Gonvick-area players lift up the opportunity to get exercise as one of the appeals of the game.

"It's a better workout than I thought," Sue Dalager, a relative new-comer to the group stated.

"It's just fun!" is the reason Mike Mason enjoys the pickleball group.

While many of the enthusiastic players have already purchased their own pickleball paddles, all of the equipment for the game is available for use for those who want to try the game. A "spectator section" has also been set up with chairs and tables for those who would like to watch the game and drink coffee.

Board of Commissioners' Meeting
January 7, 2020

The January meetings for the Clearwater County Board of Commissioners commenced on January 7, 2020 at 9:00 a.m. with Chairman Nelson presiding and Commissioners Illies, Titera, Newland and Larson present. The Board recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Agenda – Motion by Commissioner Newland, seconded by Commissioner Titera and carried, to approve the Agenda.

Election of Officers – Commissioner Newland nominated Neal Illies as Chairman. Motion by Commissioner Titera, seconded by Commissioner Larson and carried by unanimous vote, to cease nominations and appoint Neal Illies as the Chairman of the Clearwater County Board.

Commissioner Titera nominated Mark Larson as Vice-Chairman. Motion by Commissioner Newland, seconded by Commissioner Nelson and carried by unanimous vote, to cease nominations and appoint Mark Larson as the Vice-Chairman of the Clearwater County Board.

Minutes – Motion by Commissioner Larson, seconded by Commissioner Larson and carried, to approve the minutes for the month of December.

Soil & Water Conservation District – Chester Powell and Briell Prokosch presented the following motion: Motion by Commissioner Newland, seconded by Commissioner Titera

and carried, to accept the terms of the MN Department of Natural Resources Delegation Agreement for AIS Prevention Inspection of Water-related Equipment. The agreement will cover years 2020, 2021, and 2022; now set to expire on December 31, 2022.

Veterans Service Officer – Lindsey Lamwers presented the following motions: Motion by Commissioner Larson, seconded by Commissioner Titera and carried, utilization of the building and grounds fund to partition the Veteran Service Office in order to accommodate Veterans and their families that are waiting for the Veterans Service Officer with a proper seating area. Construction of the wall with a window and door is estimated at \$1,500.00.

Furniture includes a desk with storage components, one new office chair and 4 new guest chairs for Veterans to utilize in waiting area and during of-

fice meetings.

MIS – Stuart Lien presented the following motions: Motion by Commissioner Newland, seconded by Commissioner Nelson and carried, to authorize the purchase of 2020 computer replacements and technology upgrades for General Government not to exceed \$80,000.00.

Motion by Commissioner Titera, seconded by Commissioner Larson and carried, to authorize the purchase of the 2020 General Government computer & software maintenance, upgrades and support agreements not to exceed \$82,000.00.

An itemized list of expenditures was given to the Board members which meets purchasing policy guidelines.

Engineer – Dan Sauvé presented the bills, financial statement and following motions: Motion by Commissioner Larson, seconded by Commissioner Nelson and carried, to approve payment of the Clearwater County Highway Department bills as presented.

Motion by Commissioner Titera, seconded by Commissioner Newland and carried, to authorize the County Highway Department to advertise project CP 20-100: Pavement Markings, and to set date and time of letting for 10:00 a.m. on March 10th, 2020.

Motion by Commissioner Newland, seconded by Commissioner Illies and carried, to authorize the County Highway Department to ad-

vertise project CP 20-200; Regravel, and to set date and time of letting for 10:10 a.m. on March 10th, 2020.

Motion by Commissioner Illies, seconded by Commissioner Newland and carried, to authorize the County Highway Department to advertise project SAP 15-602-024; Grade Widen & Culvert Replacement, and to set date and time of letting with the County Board Coordinator.

Auditor-Treasurer – Al Paulson presented the bills and the following motions: Motion by Commissioner Larson, seconded by Commissioner Newland and carried, to approve the quote from Vern's Carpet of Fertile, MN in the amount of \$12,314.00 for carpeting and removal of old flooring in the Sheriff's Department and stairway in dispatch. This will come out of the Building and Grounds account.

Motion by Commissioner Illies, seconded by Commissioner Nelson and carried, to authorize the County Auditor to pay the submitted invoices of \$328,323.13 for the County Revenue Fund.

Al Paulson discussed a revision needed to the tobacco ordinance which is raising the age to buy tobacco from 18 to 21. This was acted on at the federal level already so stores are required to comply with this revision.

Al also informed the Board that Giziibii Board is inquiring on Clearwater County becoming a member of this Board again. By general consent, the Board agreed to not be on this Board.

Sheriff – Darin Halverson presented the following motion: Motion by Commissioner Newland, seconded by Commissioner Nelson and carried, the Clearwater County Board of Commissioners hereby appoint Candace Coulter as Emergency Management Director with 10% of her salary coming from the Emergency Management budget effective January 7, 2020.

Open – Motion by Commissioner Titera, seconded by Commissioner Nelson and carried, to re-adopt the three-day notice requirement rule. No motion or resolution can be acted on by the County Board unless all of the Board members have received the written motion or resolution of the subject matter at least three days prior to the Board meeting. The notice requirement can be waived by general consent by all Board members in the best interest of the County. If general consent is not obtained, the motion or resolution shall be tabled until the next scheduled Board meeting.

Motion by Commissioner Larson, seconded by Commissioner Newland and carried, to approve the following general Agenda for the first Board meeting of each month: Call to order/Pledge of Allegiance/Minutes & Agenda Approval. Any Department Head may meet with the County Board at any scheduled monthly meeting by arranging an appointment time with the County Board Coordinator. All other citizens wishing to meet with the Board to discuss business shall contact the Commissioner of their district, obtain approval to meet with the Board, and then the Commissioner, with the approval of the Chair, will contact the Coordinator for an appointment time.

Motion by Commissioner Larson, seconded by Commissioner Titera and carried, the Clearwater County Board of Commissioners approved the following dates for the 2019 Department Head/Work Session Meetings. These meetings are held at 9:00 a.m. in the Commissioners Room on the 2nd Floor of the Clearwater County Courthouse. 3 or more Commissioners may be in attendance at any one of these meetings. January 3, 2020; February 7, 2020; March 6, 2020; April 10, 2020; May 8, 2020; June 5, 2020; July 10, 2020; August 7, 2020; September 4, 2020; October 9, 2020; November 6, 2020; December 4, 2020.

Motion by Commissioner Newland, seconded by Commissioner Nelson and carried, to re-adopt Robert's Rules of Order as a guideline for facilitating County Board meetings.

Motion by Commissioner Larson, seconded by Commissioner Titera and carried, to authorize the Coordinator to publish a summary of County Board Minutes upon approval of the County Board. All Resolutions, policies, and Ordinances are available at the Auditor's office for review.

Motion by Commissioner Larson, seconded by Commissioner Newland and carried, to designate Leader Record as the legal paper for 2020. The County Engineer is authorized to advertise for County Highway projects on the County Website as stated in Minnesota Statutes 331a.12.

Motion by Commissioner Nelson, seconded by Commissioner Newland and carried, to authorize the County Auditor to pay routine bills prior to Board approval. These include utility bills, items which are payroll related, registration fees, Verizon bills, T & K Outdoors of Bemidji bills, unemployment, Veterans Transportation volunteer mileage, Neow Post bills, postage, meeting expense advances, grant pass through bills, or any bill with a prior Board motion which states the dollar amount. Auditor usually cuts these checks on Fridays. Audit list is prepared for bills paid which goes to the board after payment for board review. Board chair signs approved list.

Adjourn – Motion by Commissioner Newland, seconded by Commissioner Larson and carried, to adjourn the meeting at 2:23 p.m.

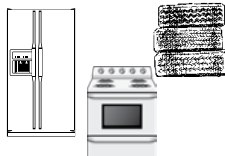

Caller ID or documents sent by email may look official but they are not.
