Snowmobile theft and recovery following fatal crash

Buzzle Township, Beltrami County - On February 19th, 2023 at approximately 11:30AM, the Beltrami County Sheriff's Office was notified of a snowmobile crash at the Clearwater and Beltrami County Line on the Soo Line Trail, near the intersection of Clearline Rd NW and Soo Line Rd NW.

A snowmobile had crashed with a tractor trailer resulting in serious injury to the female snowmobile operator. Law Enforcement and Emergency Medical Service personnel conducted life saving measures on the female but was declared deceased.

The crash is being investi-

gated by the Clearwater County Sheriff's Office.

Several hours after the crash, family and friends of the victim returned to the area to recover several snowmobiles that had been left at the scene. Unfortunately, one of the snowmobiles belonging to the family of the deceased was stolen.

The stolen snowmobile was parked on the Beltrami County side of the county border and deputies immediately began searching for the stolen snowmobile. Beltrami County Deputies followed tracks leading west from the scene and followed up on several leads that evening.

With assistance from the

Clearwater County Sheriff's Office, on February 20th a search warrant was executed at two rural addresses in Dudley Township near Leonard where snowmobile tracks matching the stolen snowmobile led. The stolen snowmobile was located at one of the residences and charges are pending on a male and female for felony theft. The Beltrami County Sheriff's Office took possession of the snowmobile and returned it to the owner.

The Beltrami County Sheriff's Office extends our condolences to the victim's family.

“Love Conquers All”

Sam and Dorothy Walton of rural Gully were special guest speakers at the Samhold Lutheran Church Ladies' Aid in Gonvick on February 16, 2023. The theme of their program was “Love Conquers All” as Dorothy and Sam were the special speakers relating to their harrowing experience with Covid. After President Eileen Lien conducted a short business meeting, the Waltons spoke to the large audience.

The Waltons' saga began on December 10, 2021, when Dorothy suffered from severe cold symptoms.

Since she is a nurse at Bemidji Public Health, she tested positive on the Covid test and was given an infusion. She was admitted to the Fosston hospital because of lack of oxygen, but her symptoms kept getting worse, and she was transferred to Essentia Hospital in Fargo on December 15th, 2021. She

doesn't have any memory of the experience at Essentia and “woke up” February 7, 2022, unable to walk or move. The next step toward recovery was physical therapy, which she still does.

During her hospital stay in Fargo, Dorothy's husband Sam (of nearly 42 years) was her faithful advocate during the entire time. Sam explained to the crowd, “I prayed a lot and the Lord promised me that Dorothy would be o.k. God also told me that he would heal Dorothy. Three of the doctors there at Essentia kept insisting that we “pull the plug” on Dorothy because her lungs were not functioning. I refused to give them permission. They tried to ‘bully’ me into the decision. They even tried to convince our three adult children-Jesse, Josh, and Zach-that they should do that. I went out into our woods and prayed to God again to save my precious wife. God again promised that he would. Her lungs began

improving and she started coming out of her nightmare coma in February. We are so grateful to God for our miracle.”

Dorothy added, “One of our biggest messages from our experience is how amazing God is. God was totally wonderful to heal me. It is hard for me to not be tearful when I tell our story and the experience was hard on our kids. I'm also grateful to all the people praying for me, too. (It still seems unreal and I still cry.) I give all the glory to God. It was truly a miracle!”

Dorothy (who is an '80 graduate of Gonvick High School) is back at her nursing job at Bemidji Public Health where she has worked for 22 years. Sam continues farming and constructing pole barns.

Following the program, coffee and goodies were served by the February 2023 group of Samhold ladies.

The Clearwater County Board of Commissioners met on Tuesday, February 21, 2023. Following the Pledge of Allegiance, and approval of the agenda and minutes from the last meeting, department heads addressed the Commissioners.

County Attorney Kathryn Lorschach requested approval to appoint a special prosecutor for an upcoming court case. Commissioner Mark Larson made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Mark Titera to authorize the County Attorney's office to appoint Al Rogalla as special prosecutor under the direction of the Clearwater County Attorney. This special assistant position would be covered under MCIT. He would be retained at the amount of \$50.00 on an hourly basis. The motion was approved.

campaign had successfully raised the required amount of money. A question was asked about the length of service for a typical K9 and Sheriff Halverson responded that it was usually 8-10 years. Following discussion, Commissioner Newland called for a vote with Commissioners Titera, Dukek, Nelson, and Larson voting yes and Commissioner Newland voting no. The motion carried 4-1. In other business, Sheriff Halverson explained that the remodel project at the jail was

taking longer than expected, but he expected that the jail would be reopened for inmates by Friday, February 24 or the next week.

County Auditor/Treasurer Allen Paulson had two items of business to discuss with the board. The first item was invoices to be paid. Commissioner Newland made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Larson to authorize the Auditor to pay submitted invoices of \$136,234.90 from the County Revenue Fund and \$26,342.90 from the Nursing Service Fund. The motion was approved. The second item was a request to repurchase a parcel of land. Commissioner Titera made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Dukek, to approve the resolution on file approving the repurchase of parcel 23.301.1110 by Sophia Wright for the price of \$2,564.74 plus recording fees, deed fee and deed tax for a total of \$2,697.39. The motion was approved.

With no further items on the agenda, the meeting was adjourned at 10:22 am.

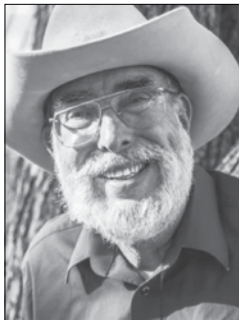
