Elaina Rojas is one of two exchange students at the Clearbrook-Gonvick High School. She answered several questions that were given to her. Her English is still limited but she had a great letter. She is living with the Eileen Miller family in Clearbrook.

Tell us about your family at home and yourself. "About my family and myself, I could say it's been a little difficult for me to arrive in a country different from mine, to be surrounded by people I don't know and away from my family life I've never been before and to a place where they speak a language completely different from mine and a language I don't know, but still, I'm happy and I try to view these changes in the best way. I try to learn everything and I'm happy to know that I reach such a beautiful family, where I feel comfortable and where I know that I'm safe, where I find laughter, madness and company. Every night we sit down to eat together and I hear them talking, many times I don't understand what they talk to me, but in them I find the patience to explain or teach me some words."

Tell us about your home country and city. "I'm from Colombia, I grew up in Armenia Quindío and it is a beautiful country where fauna and flora abound. It is a country with all kinds of music, with cheerful people. Where one can find; deserts, snow, nature and beach. About my hometown I can say that it is surrounded by moun-

tains and by the most beautiful and colorful villages, where you can enjoy the best coffee in the world (in my opinion). Colombia has absolutely everything and I'm very happy and proud to be Colombian."

What exchange program brought you to Clearbrook? "I came here on the exchange program called International Student Exchange (ISE)."

What classes are you taking? "My classes are strength and conditioning, teacher assistant, English, Personal Math, United States History, Art Appreciation and color drawing."

What are some differences at the school? "I find many things different, my classes began at 6:30 am and I did not eat lunch in school. I had two breaks at 8 am and 11 am to eat a little. I would leave at 2:45 and then I could go home to lunch or if I was going to stay in some extra class I could have lunch in the school restaurant. I also found it very rare that students are the ones who move from classrooms. In Colombia usually students have assigned a classroom for the whole year. All students have the same subjects. If someone wants to take an extra class like music, soccer, dancing or something, it has to be after normal classes. The only way to move out of the classroom is to go and rest or go to gym class or drawing class. In my school there were three classrooms for each different grade with more or less 25 students and for the other school

levels. Also on the other hand it seemed strange the main sport is basketball and in Colombia the main sport is soccer.

Are you involved in any activities in school? "Right now I'm not in any school activities but I hope to be."

Do you have any favorite food? "I'm really easy going with the food, I like everything and I'm always willing to try new things."

What are your future goals? "I graduated last year from San Luis Rey School in Armenia, Quindío. I only come here to learn English and learn about you and your culture. When I return to my country I will start university and go to study medicine. But I'm very happy to be here to meet new people, a culture different from mine and to live this beautiful experience. I found Clearbrook-Gonvick school beautiful, both the people, the coordinators, teachers and students who have always been very friendly with me."

School board meeting March 14 to award contracts on building referendum

The Clearbrook-Gonvick School board has been having working sessions for a future referendum. The school building is twenty years old and they are looking for upgrades. They have had presentations from architects and construction management teams.

On March 7 the board met with another architect firm; TSR (Armstrong, Torseth, Skold

and Rydeen) on their referendum Architectural and Engineering service.

Blaine Parkos and Sarah Fox promoted their company which has been in business since 1944. They stated that 98% of what they do is school buildings. They would have a pre-referendum meeting on what the district is looking for and a facility study

that they would do.

After that meeting the board was setting up a special board meeting on Tuesday March 14 at 7:00 P.M. to award a Construction Management firm for the potential building referendum and awarding a pre-referendum/architect firm for the potential building referendum.

Fundraising for a K9 unit for Clearwater County started

On February 21, 2023, the Clearwater County Sheriff's Office received authorization from the Clearwater County Board of Commissioners to conduct fundraising for a K9 unit. It has been a long time, 2008 to be exact, since Clearwater County has had a K9 unit. I am excited for this opportunity and I wanted to announce this to the public.

The K9 unit will consist of a Clearwater County Deputy who will attend a six-week training session along with a K9 selected by the trainer. The two will learn to work together and will be trained in the detection of illegal drugs, tracking for missing or lost people, and the detection and apprehension of criminal suspects. The addition of a K9 unit for Clearwater County will add a resource that has been missing for many years and will benefit all communities within Clearwater County and surrounding area.

Deputy Chase Moses has been selected to be the K9 handler for our office. Deputy Moses moved here, along with his wife, after serving in the military as a military police officer. He has worked for the Sheriff's Office in both the jail and as a deputy for approximately a year and a half. He has been instrumental in getting this project under way. It takes dedication to be a K9 handler and Deputy Moses is showing he has what it takes.

Earlier in my career, I had the privilege of being a K9 Officer for the City of Bagley from 1997-2005 with K9 Max. I know first hand how important a K9 can be in assisting law enforcement with a broad range of activities. Not only can they be instrumental in the detection of illegal drugs, they can expedite the searching for missing or lost people and also apprehending criminal suspects. They are extremely valuable when searching for evidence and assisting law enforcement in searching and clearing buildings where suspects may be hiding.

Our goal is to send Deputy Moses to training in May along with his new partner, K9 Akim (pronounced "Akeem"). We have not met K9 Akim yet, but he has been selected by the trainer to be partnered with Deputy Moses. We have pictures of K9 Akim and are eagerly waiting to meet him after we have the funding in place. K9 Akim is a one-year old Sable German Shepherd from the Czech Republic. The training will be done through McDonough K9 out of Anoka, MN. Mark Mc-



Donough has been training dogs since 2000 and worked as a police officer for 32 years.

Starting a K9 program can be costly. The costs associated with starting a K9 unit include the cost of the dog and the six-week training session, hotel and meal expenses for the deputy, a secure dog kennel for housing the dog at the deputy's residence, upfitting a squad with a kennel, dog food and veterinary bills and other miscellaneous K9 equipment. The total cost to get the program operational is approximately \$32,000.

To help alleviate any local tax payer burden, we are attempting to raise all the funds necessary to start this program. This is where you can help. We are looking for

On Monday I voted against the largest bonging bill package in Minnesota history. In a time when our state more than double the most recent peak budget surplus, the fact that the legislature wants to borrow even more money is unconscionable. There are some great projects in the bill, projects that are important for the future of Minnesota, but to borrow that much money when we have the cash available to fund these projects. This bill will cost taxpayers hundreds of millions in additional interest over the life of these bonds. Families don't balance their own check-books this way, so why should legislators treat their money any differently?

Safe and Sound Public Safety Plan

On Thursday House and Senate Republicans unveiled our public safety package which includes 17 different bills from 15 different Republican authors across the state. Confronting the criminal threat would include new laws to add a new crime of carjacking to state statute, increase penalties for fleeing police in a motor vehicle, align fentanyl to the same weight thresholds and penalties as heroin, and



increase sentences for those convicted with at least two prior crimes of violence.

We continue to throw our support behind our state's law enforcement officers with robust recruitment, training, and retention plans. The Safe & Sound Minnesota plan provides \$1 million for Pathway to Policing, the award-winning program that brings new recruits into public safety from other careers. There is also included \$5 million for college scholarships and technology to help law enforcement students prepare for their role and \$15 million for bodycams for law enforcement departments.

In Committee

In the Public Safety Committee this week we heard Representative Navotney's bill, HF 2253. This legislation will fund the expansion of use-of-force training making it available to many more of our police officers across the state. Our police force has an important job to do and we should be providing them with all the resources they need to do their job effectively.

We settled back, in what we considered a learned and curious pose. We probably weren't, though.

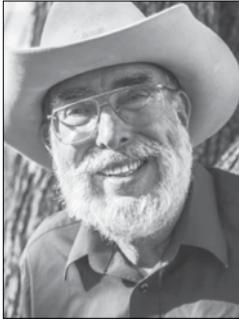
