March is Women's History Month in MN
Governor Mark Dayton has proclaimed March to be "Women's History Month" in the State of Minnesota.

A special Presidential Proclamation has been issued every year since 1995 to honor the achievements of American women

Did you know?

St. Patrick's Day is rife with tradition, but arguably no tradition is more eye-opening than the one most synonymous with the city of Chicago. Each year, the Chicago River is dyed green for St. Patrick's Day. A tradition that began in 1962. The dyeing of the Chicago River traces its roots to something that the Windy City's historians believe has nothing to do with the famed Christian missionary and primary patron saint of Ireland. In 1962, pollution-control workers in Chicago employed dyes to trace illegal sewage discharges in the river. These workers realized the dye they were using turned the river green, the color most synonymous with Ireland and St. Patrick's Day celebrations. So that year, 100 pounds of green vegetable dye were released into the Chicago River to celebrate St. Patrick's Day. The tradition has endured, though much less dye is now released into the river in an effort to limit the environmental impact of the tradition. While St. Patrick's Day celebrants across the globe are familiar with the tradition of dyeing the Chicago River green for St. Patrick's Day, debate exists as to where the idea came from. Some believe a less successful attempt to dye a river in Savannah, Georgia green, in 1961 ultimately laid the foundation for the tradition in Chicago.

SNOW

It's the kind of day that can catch you in between wanting to do something and wanting to stay put. February in Northern Minnesota has its feet firmly planted in winter. The brilliant landscape painted predominantly in one color promises I won't have to mow the lawn but I'll need to wear boots if I go outside. And I could go out there and do something, if I really wanted to... like say, shoveling... or I could stay inside and write.

There are days for dreaming and days for doing; the dilemma is discerning which is which. I could sweep the floor. I could start some laundry. I could sit in the chair and read a book. What I find myself doing is looking out the window and challenging myself to write something that captures this moment. I think too often I live in the past or in the future. I find it difficult to soak in moments one by one. I don't believe it has to do with the pace of my life but rather with my attitude. I need practice, so here goes.

Snow is a clever fellow; resting comfortably on the ground like a bundled blanket or a taut sheet— depending on where you look. It can also cling to the thinnest branches as agile as a sparrow—seemingly balancing on nothing. Sometimes it likes to recline in clumps on pine branches until an errant breeze gives it a shove. Today the snow is lacy and feather-light, tumbling off the branches like fairy dust. The pale sky seems to have consulted with the snow today about what to wear. A hint of grey casts just enough contrast to let the ground shine in bridal white. Bare trees marry the landscape; their branches frosted with snow and set against the backdrop of the sky's vast expanse.

Then reality interrupts; the sound of big machinery and scraping metal as the snowplow does its necessary work. Two passes to reveal the street again and preach to you about the merit of not digging yourself out before it goes by. Shoveling wouldn't be such a tedious chore if the snow would just stay where you put it. But it is not content to be sedentary (as I am today), it must cavort with the wind when it beckons and revisit old stomping grounds. On pleasant mid-winter days the snow has the habit of undergoing a miraculous metamorphosis; gleaming and sparkling in the sun, icicles



will dangle delicately but the beauty is treacherous as your feet will soon tell you.

As I sit inside on my recliner I hear the sounds of the house squeaking and cracking in the background. The furnace kicks on occasionally but the house is peaceful. I have settled under a toasty blanket. Let's review that because it's a wonderful winter recipe: lazy morning, comfy chair, cozy blanket and a laptop on my lap and what have I stirred together in this bowl of "living in the moment" creativity? Something very ordinary but somewhat predictable: a cat bed... and I'm getting glares about just how much space I require for my laptop.

Now that a balance has been struck, gentle snores hint at the amazing ability of cats to do nothing and something all at the same time. When they are sleepy they sleep. When they are playful they play and usually at 3am. When they are hungry they eat and seem to think any open cupboard or fridge door is an invitation to do just that. They are experts at living in the present moment. And now I realize there is another recipe being stirred here. Main ingredient: comfy recliner. Top with: toasty blanket and embellish with cat. What am I making? What do you think? Mm-hmm... a nap.

1 tsp. lemon extract
1 tsp. vanilla
Bake 425° for 8 minutes



Polk Churches
working to Feed
Starving Children

*A number of Polk County churches are working on the 2018 annual "Feed My Starving Children" campaign to pack 404,000 meals April 6-8 in Grand Forks for starvation-impacted children around the world.

*In the first six years of the program, 19 Polk churches raised \$43,684 that paid for 292,827 meals sent to Haiti, Dominican Republic, The Philippines, Namibia and Nicaragua.

*The 404,000 meals for the April packing will cost \$88,000 for ingredients of which \$35,400 was raised by March 4, leaving a shortage of \$53,500.

*"This shortfall is a matter of great concern to us," said Coordinating Committee Co-Chair Jodie Storhaug, "but we are proceeding in faith that the Christian community will respond to this need."

Don't let
Patty's Day pass
without Irish coffee

St. Patrick's Day is rife with traditions, many of which involve food and drink.

While pints of Guinness might garner the bulk of the beverage attention on St. Patrick's Day, that beloved creamy stout is not the only Irish-inspired drink to hoist on March 17.

In the mid-20th century, chef Joe Sheridan was working in Foynes, County Limerick, when a group of travelers who had been scheduled to fly to the United States became stranded due to inclement weather that grounded their plane.

When his weary travelers arrived in Sheridan's place of business, he served the them coffee with some Irish whiskey mixed in. When the group inquired as to what they were drinking, Sheridan reportedly told them, "that's Irish coffee."

While Irish coffee recipes vary from place to place, those who want a more traditional recipe this St. Patrick's Day can prepare the following concoction courtesy of A.J. Rathbun's "Good Spirits" (Harvard Common Press).

Irish Coffee

1 1/2 ounces Irish whiskey
1/2 ounce Simple Syrup (see below)

6 ounces fresh hot coffee
Whipped cream (optional)
1. Add the whiskey and simple syrup to a mug.
2. Fill the mug with hot coffee. If something extra is desired, top with whipped cream.

Simple Syrup
Makes 4 1/2 cups

21/2 cups water
3 cups sugar
1. Add the water and sugar to a medium-size saucepan. Stirring occasionally, bring the mixture to a boil over medium-high heat. Lower the heat a bit, keeping the mixture at a low boil for 5 minutes, stirring occasionally.
2. Turn off the heat, and let the syrup cool completely in the pan. Store in a clean, airtight container in the refrigerator.

NOTICE OF DELINQUENT TAXES

DISTRICT COURT

9TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT

TO: ALL PERSONS WITH A LEGAL INTEREST IN THE PARCELS OF REAL PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN THE FOLLOWING DELINQUENT TAX LIST

A list of real property in Polk County on which delinquent property taxes and penalties are due has been filed with the district court administrator of Polk County. This list is published to inform all persons that the listed property is subject to forfeiture because of delinquent taxes.

The property owner, taxpayer, or other interested persons must either pay the tax and penalty, plus interest and costs, or file a written objection with the district court administrator. The objection must be filed by April 24, 2018, stating the reason why the tax or penalty is not due on the property. If no objection is filed, a court judgement will be entered against the property for the unpaid tax, penalty, interest and costs.

For property under court judgement, the period of redemption begins on May 14, 2018, and ends three years later. The period of redemption means the time within which taxes must be paid to avoid losing the property through forfeiture.

You may qualify to enter into a confession of judgement as an alternative method to paying off the delinquent tax amount and avoiding forfeiture. This allows you to pay the delinquent balance in equal annual installments, with a down payment due at the time you enter into the confession. The length of the installment plan varies: five years for commercial-industrial/public utility property; 10 years for all other properties.

It should also be noted by property homesteaders that you are ineligible to receive the Property Tax Refund while you owe delinquent property tax.

To avoid forfeiture, taxes on property must be paid by May 14, 2021.

To determine how much interest and costs must be added to pay the tax in full, contact the Polk County Taxpayer Service Center, Government Center, 612 North Broadway, Suite 207, Crookston, Minnesota, 56716-1452. The telephone number is (218) 281-2554.

The program will allow children to be supervised in a school setting that will give them access to technology activities, academic based activities, arts and crafts, physical education activities, and access to summer recreation activities such as baseball, softball and swimming lessons.

The program will again consist of different plans that can be purchased separately or one can choose to access any or all of the program plans.

Plan A: This program will consist of access to the Summer Activity Block. Students could be dropped off at the school at 7:30 a.m. and could be picked up at 2:30 p.m. or earlier if more convenient to your schedule. The students would work through different activity blocks throughout the day which could consist of technology, arts and crafts, physical education, Summer Recreation, and academics to name a few. All summer recreation practices would take place at the school and students would access their practice or games from the school. Breakfast and lunch will be provided to students as part of the program.

Plan B: This program will consist of child supervision for the hours after the Summer Activity Block. Supervision that could be purchased is for the hours from 2:30-5:30 p.m. This would allow working parents to still have supervision for their child until they are able to get off from work and pick up their child.

Plan C: Once the “Beyond the Bell” Summer Activity Pro-

gram ends for kids, parents may still be in need of child supervision for the remainder of the summer. Child Supervision will be made available at the school from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

Once we finalize plans you can pick and choose what fits your needs. We will arrange for a sign-up in late April.

*** Breakfast and Lunch will be provided during the day as part of the program for all students. If other students would like to eat here at school during the summer, please notify the Hot Lunch Dept. We will serve all students during the summer.

Minnesota Legislators introduce Tobacco 21 bill

Bipartisan measure will prevent youth tobacco use, save lives.

Today a bipartisan group of Minnesota lawmakers introduced a bill in the Minnesota House to raise the state tobacco sale age to 21.

Minnesota would become the sixth state in the nation to pass a Tobacco 21 law, which aims to protect youth from tobacco addiction and prevent death and disease.

The proposal was announced at the State Capitol by Representative Dario Anselmo (R-Edina). Bill coauthors include Representatives Keith Franke (R-St. Paul Park), Sandy Layman (R-Cohasset), Dave Baker (R-Willmar), Mark Uglem (R-Champlin), Mary Kunesh-Podein (DFL-New Brighton), Laurie Halverson (DFL-Eagan), Rena Moran (DFL-St. Paul), and Mike Freiberg (DFL-Golden Valley). The legislators were joined by youth, medical professionals and supporters from the Minnesotans for a Smoke-Free Generation coalition.

"As a parent and as a legislator, I want to do everything in my power to ensure young people are free from addiction," said lead author Rep. Anselmo.

"The harms of tobacco use reach all of our families and communities — whether we

are Republicans, Democrats, rural or urban. Minnesotans are leaders, and I want us to be at the forefront of this issue. I hope we can all come together and support this commonsense public policy change that makes the health of young Minnesotans a top priority."

Raising the tobacco sale age to 21 is an effective way to keep commercial tobacco products away from young people. Nearly all addicted smokers — 95 percent — start before age 21.

In Minnesota, raising the tobacco age to 21 would prevent an estimated 30,000 kids from becoming smokers over the next 15 years. Last year, a Tobacco 21 bill was introduced in the Minnesota Senate.

Several Minnesota communities have taken the lead on Tobacco 21, passing local policies to protect youth. Since 2017, five Minnesota cities have passed Tobacco 21 policies, including Plymouth, Edina, Bloomington, St. Louis Park and North Mankato. Several other Minnesota localities are actively considering Tobacco 21 policies.

To date, five states (Hawaii, California, New Jersey, Maine and Oregon) and more than 290 localities have raised the tobacco sale age to 21.

"Driving down healthcare

costs is another top priority for me," added Rep. Anselmo. "Reducing tobacco use, which costs Minnesota more than \$7 billion a year in lost productivity and excess health care, will make a big impact."

There is ample evidence that the tobacco industry aggressively markets to 18- to 21-year olds to recruit replacement tobacco users, using tactics like candy flavoring, magazine advertisements and event sponsorships to attract young people to tobacco.

Raising the tobacco age would reduce teens' ability to buy tobacco products themselves or access them through friends.

Young people, including advocates who have helped to pass local Tobacco 21 policies, joined the event to call for legislators to support a statewide Tobacco 21 law.

"Minnesota has a choice to make," local advocate and American Cancer Society Cancer Action Network volunteer Caitlin DeVos said. "We can lead the way toward a tobacco-free future and put the health of our community and young people first, or we can let Big Tobacco companies continue to profit off selling deadly products to our teens. It should be an easy choice."

Recent data show the tobac-

co industry's tactics have disrupted Minnesota's progress in lowering tobacco use. In fact, for the first time in 17 years, the Minnesota Youth Tobacco Survey found an increase in youth tobacco use.

The survey demonstrated the urgent need to address rising youth tobacco use, which is led by easy access and youth-targeted flavoring, products and advertising.

"Passing Tobacco 21 would send a strong message to the nation that Minnesota is still a leader on tobacco prevention," Molly Moilanen, Co-Chair of the Minnesotans for a Smoke-Free Generation coalition, said.

"Thank you to Rep. Anselmo and all the bill authors for standing up for the next generation of Minnesotans."
