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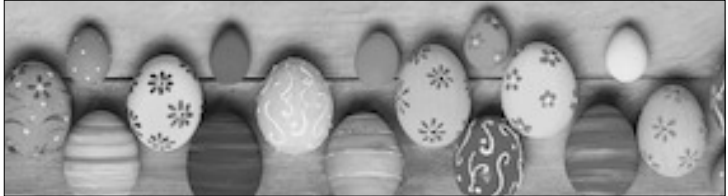

The Win-E-Mac Honor Society recently held an event titled "The Ultimate Pajama Party," which is a pajama drive, where students and staff brought donations and/or pairs of new pajamas to be donated to the Battered Women's Shelter. Chairperson, Tyra Wilson was inspired by Renee Rongen's movement titled: The Ultimate Pajama Party. Rongen, an international Keynote Speaker and Author created the movement after her friend was murdered at the hands of her husband.

Many nights her friend had to flee in the night with her kids dressed to get to a safe house or domestic violence shelter without pajamas or those items that gave them comfort. "It was a way to honor her memory", says Rongen. "One pair of pajamas, one child, one mom safe and in their own pajamas for one night." For nearly 10 years Rongen has held these events in conjunction with her speaking events across the globe. Together with her awareness and those like Tyra holding pajama parties in their schools, the movement has surpassed over 1 Million Pairs of Pajamas.

Local Work meeting scheduled for East Polk

The East Polk County Soil and Water Conservation District (SWCD) in cooperation with the Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) will convene a local work group (LWG) meeting to provide guidance and discuss local resource conservation concerns and NRCS programs in East Polk County.

The local work group includes representatives from cooperating federal, state and local agencies, conservation organizations, and the public to provide localized information on natural resource priorities in the East Polk County SWCD.

"I would encourage participation from local farmers, forestland owners and other land users to attend this meeting because the local work group values the knowledge that our local land users can bring to the table," said Jim Schwab, and District Conservationist. "NRCS has always been a locally led conservation agency working in cooperation with SWCDs to provide services to local land users on a voluntary basis."

The local work groups are the foundation of the Focused Conservation Approach. The local work group can define conservation needs and help localize efforts to address specific resource concerns, Schwab added.

The East Polk County SWCD local work group will meet at the USDA Service Center, McIntosh, MN, 10:00-

Glacial Ridge Prairie Grouse viewing opportunities

Each spring, Glacial Ridge National Wildlife Refuge staff place two small, two or three person public viewing blinds alongside the dancing grounds (aka- leks) of greater prairie chickens and sharp-tailed grouse within the Refuge.

These native prairie grouse species are unique in their behavior each spring when males gather at regular breeding sites and engage in tremendous territorial displays, in all hopes of attracting a nearby female. The antics include an array of calls, booms, leaps, foot stomping, and chasing, among other "dance moves".

The blinds are positioned adjacent to the lek, so they don't disturb the birds, yet are close to the action. For many visitors, this is a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity.

This is generally an early morning activity, with visitors needing to show up at their blind a full hour before sunrise. The early alarm clock is well worth it though, as the displays

can be amazing and provide for terrific photo and video opportunities. When you reserve a blind, you will be provided maps, spatial coordinates, and written directions to it. The trail to each blind is marked with a number of reflectors that will be highly visible in the dark with a flashlight.

If visitors can be situated in the blind before sunrise and stay quiet, the "show" put on by the birds is usually tremendous. Grouse activity at the leks usually tapers off around 8:00 am.

Reservations for this unique activity can be made beginning April 18th through late May. Because of the extended winter weather this year, the starting date is beginning about a week later than normal.

Grace Community Food Shelf Advisory Board Meeting

Grace Community Food Shelf, serving the communities of Erskine, McIntosh, Winger, and Mentor will hold its quarterly Advisory Board Meeting on Thursday evening, April 19th, at 7:00 PM in the Basement Meeting Room at Grace Lutheran Church, 332 Vance Ave, in Erskine.

The Grace Community Food Shelf is here to help people facing hunger in our communities.

On the average we serve 26 families with 32 pounds of food per family per month. This translates to helping over 60 people with the distribution of over 900 pounds of food each month. 50% of these people are between the ages of 19 and 65, 27% are 18 and under and 23%

are over 65. The Food Shelf is open the second and third Thursdays of each month from 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM. Once each month we also distribute the Nutrition Assistance Program for Seniors (NAPS) food boxes. We have two opportunities for people to help: As a Food Shelf Volunteer – We are looking for two more people to join our team of volunteers. No experience necessary, we will train you. The commitment is one Thursday from 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM on an alternating month basis. You will work into the schedule with five other volunteers. As an Advisory Board Member – We are looking for people from each of the communities

The Badger Township Story

According to Old Township records, the first annual town meeting of badger Township was held March 9, 1886 at the S Linset home. T. Nelson, Hans O. Lee, and L.O. Stenseth that were elected as supervisors with T. Nelson serving as chairman, Henry Arndt as treasurer, Ole T. Berge as clerk, Ole Doversy as constable and Hans Carlson as assessor.

At this meeting it was decided to raise \$50 for the year as expense. On motion resolved that all residents of the township should work three days of poll tax.

H O M E S T E A D E R S WHOSE FARMS ARE STILL IN THE GENERATION

Erick E. Skiple was born and Voss, Norway March 16, 1853. He came to the United States to settle in Goodhue County in Minnesota. In 1883 he homesteaded in section 30 of Badger Township. His sons Joseph and Edward are now owners and operators of his farm.

Hendrek Skiple was born in Voss, Norway November 25, 1849. He came to the United States to Goodhue County in Minnesota. In 1883 he homesteaded and section 31 of Badger Township. Johnnie one of his sons, is presently the owner of his farm.

Peder Carlson was born May 7, 1854 at Ostland, Norway. He came to the United States in 1868. In 1883 he homesteaded in section 32 of Badger Township. A grandson, Stanley Carlson is now the owner and operator of this farm.

Adolf O. Anderson was born in Sweden in 1857. He came to the United States in 1864. In 1883 he homesteaded and section 29 of badger Township. He passed away in 1940. His wife still survives and lives with her two sons, Arthur and Clifford, who operate the farm.

Andrew Olson Hoel was born on the Gaarden Hoel at Ends vold Norway on January 19, 1844. He came to the United States at the age of 22 to Fillmore County in Minnesota. In 1883 he homesteaded and section 33 of Badger Township. He passed away April 29, 1927. His son Martin is now owner and operator of this Farm.

Hans O. Lee was born in Norway April 30, 1858. He came to the United States at the age of nine with his parents to Castle Rock, Wisconsin in Grant County. Upon opening of the 13 towns in 1883 he filed on land and section 7 in Badger Township. There he lived until his death in 1945. His grandson, Arthur W. Lee is now owner and operator of this farm.

O. T. Wold, a native of Norway, was born June 9, 1858. He came to the United States in 1877. He was a carpenter by trade. In 1883 he homesteaded in Section 8 of Badger Township. Since his death on August 13, 1933 his farm has been operated by his son, Talmer.

Thor Johnson Frette was born at Etme Bergen, Norway in 1842. He came to the United States and settled at Thompson, North Dakota in 1882. In 1883 he homesteaded and section 14 of Badger Township. He passed away in 1905. His farm is now owned by his son, Osmond Frette.

Ole Olson Doversy was born in Faguness Valdres, Norway on May 6, 1854. He came to the United States and settled in Manamonie, Wisconsin. He came to Polk County in 1883 and homesteaded in section 9 of Badger Township. He passed away on his Homestead in 1934. His daughter, Mrs. Carrie Hallebrot and also his son Oliver are now living on his homestead.

Knute Espeseth squatted on land in the Thirteen Towns awaiting its re-opening for settlement and homesteaded in Section 3 of Badger Township in 1883. They had a family of ten children. Both Mr. and Mrs. Espeseth passed away in 1906. There's son Knute is still in Badger Township on Section 35.

RiverView Recovery Center invites public to April presentations

April is National Alcohol Awareness Month.

In recognition, RiverView Recovery Center and several partners are planning free events in the region.

Presenting at these events will be Michael DeLeon, founder of Steered Straight Inc., a non-profit organization that focuses on steering youth in a positive direction, teaching them about life choices and helping them understand the consequences of their actions. "I don't want my past to be their future," DeLeon shared.

"My 63-year-old mother was strangled and killed on Mother's Day, and I'm 100 percent responsible for that. I brought this madness into her life. I stand before you as a person who has to live with that fact for the rest of my life."

After nearly eight years of drug addiction and gang involvement, DeLeon spent 12 years in state prison and half-way houses for a gang-related homicide.

Today he describes himself as "a successfully acclimated ex-offender". Since his release from prison, he has earned three Associate's Degrees; a Baccalaureate Degree in Business Management, with a minor in Criminal Justice; and a Certified Alcohol and Drug Counselor educational certificate. He is now in the process of obtaining his Master's Degree in Social Work, as well as pursuing his Licensed Clinical Alcohol and Drug Counselor standing.

He travels the country sharing his personal journey of the troubled road of a life entwined in drugs.

DeLeon also founded Stay in Your Lane Media and has produced documentaries, including "Marijuana X" with

be produced, the potential for resistance is greater the next generation. Roger Becker, a weed scientist at the University of Minnesota informs landowners that, "it is a much easier task to control resistant weeds early on in the invasion process before the seed bank has a chance to buildup, creating the potential for a high population expressing in subsequent crops, and ensure several years of effort to manage the problem due to seed dormancy."

He also mentions that, "managers should rotate different modes of action for the herbicides that they use. Additionally, use of soil applied herbicides that have residual activity coupled with post emergence herbicide options with different modes of action will help delay the development of herbicide resistance."

How does a person identify an herbicide resistant weed in the field? There is no definitive way to positively identify a resistant plant in the field but there can be a greater suspicion, especially if targeted chemical controls are not effectively managing a plant population.

If there is a suspicion, plants samples can be taken and brought to a lab to be tested. Jeff Gunsolus, another University of Minnesota weed scientist, says that, "there are lab-based diagnostic tests available for one mechanism of glyphosate resistance and one of two known mutations for resistance to PPO herbicides (e.g. Cobra and Flexstar)."

These are useful tests but unfortunately, a negative test for resistance does not guar-

antee that resistance due to another resistance mechanism isn't possible.

The much more extensive and labor intensive weed grow outs and multiple rate applications are still the best way to determine resistance. Hence most farmers and consultants rely on past precedent and infield symptoms."

One thing is for sure, no plant can be identified or differentiated for herbicide resistance with the naked eye in the field.

Drones are being used in some parts of the country to look for these herbicide resistant plants, but they still have to be ground-truthed and laboratory tested to positively show herbicide resistance.

Did you know?

Essentia Health cancer patients benefit from generous partnership with the University of Minnesota.

Nearly half of all Minnesotans will be diagnosed with a potentially life-threatening cancer during their lifetime. Patients at Essentia Health-Fosston will soon have better access to new cancer treatments and enhanced care thanks to a new state-funded partnership between University of Minnesota and the state's major health systems, including Essentia Health.

As part of the Minnesota Discovery Research and Innovation (MnDRIVE) partnership with the State of Minnesota, the University is launching the Minnesota Cancer Clinical Trials Network (MNCCTN) with multiple locations across the state.

Led by the Masonic Cancer Center, University of Minnesota, the goal of the MNCCTN is to improve cancer outcomes for all Minnesotans through greater access to cancer clinical trials in prevention, treatment, and survivorship. The partnership will provide Essentia \$500,000 to support expanding access to clinical trials.

Cancer patients in northern Minnesota have already benefited from access to clinical trials at Essentia Health's Cancer Centers in Duluth, Brainerd and Fargo.

"The State's cancer research network will augment the work we are currently doing at Essentia's cancer clinical trial program to provide our patients greater access to the ground-breaking research from institutions in Minnesota," says Dr. Bret Friday, a hematologist/oncologist at Essentia Health's Cancer Center in Duluth.

"This MnDRIVE initiative fuels research that addresses a pressing challenge—access to world-class cancer care for Minnesotans in every corner of our state," said University of Minnesota President Eric Kaler. "We are grateful for the State of Minnesota's support for the University's work to advance innovative and quality healthcare for Minnesotans."

56 percent of Minnesotans have fewer options for treatment because they live more than 30 miles from a hospital or clinic that offers access to clinical trials. By bringing cancer clinical trials to those liv-



ing in Greater Minnesota, the MNCCTN will increase access to potentially lifesaving and life-changing therapies and treatments, strengthen healthcare systems, create more equitable access to care, and could improve cancer outcomes throughout the state.

"Early cancer screening and world-class care saved my life," said Governor Mark Dayton. "The \$8 million in new MnDRIVE funding secured last session will help ensure greater access to new cancer treatments and enhanced care for patients across Minnesota."

"It was an honor to serve as the chief author of legislation to support this network," said Rep. Bud Nornes, R-Fergus Falls. "As the higher education chairman in the House, I am pleased to see the U of M take the lead on such an important project. I look forward to seeing this endeavor bring positive results in cancer treatments and care delivery."

The State's cancer research network is a collaboration between the Masonic Cancer Center, Essentia's Community Cancer Research Program, Mayo Clinic Cancer Center, Fairview Health System, Sanford Community Oncology Research Consortium and The Hormel Institute. In all, there will be 15 new locations across Minnesota that will participate in MNCCTN cancer clinical trials in the first year of the program with additional sites across the state to be added in the subsequent years.

With the inception of the State's cancer research network, Essentia plans to expand access to cancer trials at multiple clinics, including Virginia, Hibbing, Deer River, Detroit Lakes, Park Rapids, Fosston along with Riverwood Healthcare Center in Aitkin. Additional centers will be added in the future. The cancer network is currently funded for

Why scout for herbicide resistant weeds?

Shane Blair, Minnesota Department of Agriculture

A growing problem that is costing farmers more money each year is herbicide resistant weeds. The primary driver for resistant weeds comes from the repeated use of the same herbicide with the same mode of action year after year.

What can be done? Scouting for herbicide resistant weeds throughout the growing season and even when harvest time comes around can be very

beneficial.

The earlier the detection, the more time there is allotted to eliminate the plant or patch by mowing, hand removal, and/or herbicide application before the plant(s) produces seed. Scouting for these weeds and defining where and who the "escapes" are can help determine what formulation of herbicide to use or what could be used next season.

If seed from an herbicide resistant weed is allowed to

NOTICE OF DELINQUENT TAXES

TO: ALL PERSONS WITH A LEGAL INTEREST IN THE PARCELS OF REAL PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN THE FOLLOWING DELINQUENT TAX LIST

A list of real property in Polk County on which delinquent property taxes and penalties are due has been filed with the district court administrator of Polk County. This list is published to inform all persons that the listed property is subject to forfeiture because of delinquent taxes.

The property owner, taxpayer, or other interested persons must either pay the tax and penalty, plus interest and costs, or file a written objection with the district court administrator. The objection must be filed by April 24, 2018, stating the reason why the tax or penalty is not due on the property. If no objection is filed, a court judgement will be entered against the property for the unpaid tax, penalty, interest and costs.

For property under court judgement, the period of redemption begins on May 14, 2018, and ends three years later. **The period of redemption means the time within which taxes must be paid to avoid losing the property through forfeiture.**

You may qualify to enter into a confession of judgement as an alternative method to paying off the delinquent tax amount and avoiding forfeiture. This allows you to pay the delinquent balance in equal annual installments, with a down payment due at the time you enter into the confession. The length of the installment plan varies: five years for commercial-industrial/public utility property; 10 years for all other properties.

It should also be noted by property homesteaders that you are ineligible to receive the Property Tax Refund while you owe delinquent property tax.

To avoid forfeiture, taxes on property must be paid by May 14, 2021.

To determine how much interest and costs must be added to pay the tax in full, contact the Polk County Taxpayer Service Center, Government Center, 612 North Broadway, Suite 207, Crookston, Minnesota, 56716-1452. The telephone number is (218) 281-2554.
