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CHS acquires Northstar Agri Industries canola processing plant

North America's leading farmer-owned cooperative and a global energy, grains and foods company, announced today it has acquired Northstar Agri Industries canola processing and refining plant near Hallock, Minn., from PICO Northstar Hallock LLC, a majority-owned subsidiary of PICO Holdings, Inc.

The Hallock canola plant processes more than 400,000 tons of canola seed annually into canola oil and canola meal.

"Acquisition of Northstar Agri Industries adds value to CHS owners across the enterprise from inputs to value-added processing ingredients to the

marketplace," said Tom Malecha, CHS vice president, Processing and Food Ingredients. "Specifically, the acquisition expands our oilseed processing platform to include canola in addition to soybeans, adds to CHS presence in Canada, expands CHS oil product offerings to global food companies, and links growers purchasing canola seed from CHS-owned retail outlets to an integrated supply chain."

Neil Juhnke, president, Northstar Agri Industries, said CHS was a good fit because it is a financially strong, farmer-owned cooperative with Minnesota roots that is committed to growth and profitability. "The new ownership structure adds security and many value-added opportunities for canola growers in our region," said Juhnke.

The Hallock facility will be rebranded as CHS and the 57 employees at the Hallock plant will become CHS employees.

Sen. Skoe receives CGMC Legislator of Distinction Award

ST. PAUL, Minn. – Sen. Rod Skoe (DFL-Clearbrook) was recognized by the Coalition of Greater Minnesota Cities (CGMC) July 23 during the Coalition's three-day summer conference in Duluth for his positive impact on the state's tax policy.

In his fourth term in the Minnesota Senate, Sen. Skoe currently serves as chair of the Senate Tax Committee. The Legislator of Distinction Award is given to legislators who played key roles in advancing CGMC's policy during the preceding session.

Two of the CGMC's key initiatives for 2015 were included in the Senate tax bill: an increase in Local Government Aid – bringing it back to its 2002 funding level – and the creation of a new workforce housing tax credit. The House version of the bill failed to include the workforce housing tax credit and would have cut the LGA program by \$84 million. While the Legislature ultimately did not pass an omnibus tax bill this year, Sen. Skoe's efforts helped to keep these key priorities in play for 2016.

"Sen. Skoe is a long-time supporter of the CGMC and the LGA program," said Heidi Omerza, president of the CGMC and a member of the Ely City Council. "We are grateful to have a tax chair in the Senate who understands the needs of rural communities."

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Polk County Sheriff

On 7-26-15, the Polk County Sheriff's Office responded to a suspicious vehicle call in rural East Grand Forks. The caller was able to give Polk County Dispatch a license plate, and the vehicle had been reported stolen from Itasca County. The caller said there was a male and female with the car.

When deputies arrived, both parties had fled the area on foot. During a search of the area, it was learned the female had been transported to Altru Hospital in Grand Forks by a private party. The female stated she had been forced to get into the car at gunpoint by her boyfriend at a location in East Grand Forks. She suffered non-life threatening injuries.

A search of the East Grand Forks area resulted in the suspect being located, arrested, and transported to Northwest Regional Corrections Center in Crookston.

The male was charged with kidnapping, 2nd degree assault, possession of stolen property, and being a felon in possession of a firearm. He will appear on 7-28-15.

The case is still under investigation and no other information will be released at this time.

The Polk County Sheriff's Office was assisted by the East Grand Forks Police Department, and US Border Patrol.

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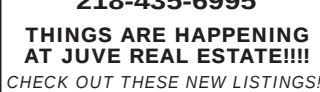

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Ask a Trooper

by *Sgt. Neil Dickenson of the Minnesota State Patrol*

Question: Is it "legal" to leave your dog in a car (summertime) with a/c and car running but locked? We occasionally will do this while grabbing a quick bite to eat or running a fast errand.

Answer: Minnesota State Statute 346.57 says, "A person may not leave a dog or a cat unattended in a standing or parked motor vehicle in a manner that endangers the dog's or cat's health or safety. A peace officer, as defined in section 626.84, a humane agent, a dog warden, or a volunteer or professional member of a fire or rescue department of a political subdivision may use reasonable force to enter a motor vehicle and remove a dog or cat which has been left in the vehicle in violation of subdivision 1.

The law addresses the issue of the unattended pet in a "standing or parked motor vehicle" but also states "a manner that endangers the dog's or cat's health or safety." You mention



that the dog is left in a running car, with the air conditioning on and doors locked. I see a few issues:

-Where is owner of the vehicle and when are they coming back?

-How would law enforcement know the air conditioner was on or working when approaching the vehicle?

-What if the vehicle's engine quits running?

-Some cities with high auto thefts, as well as for noise reasons in residential areas, have ordinances in place so that a vehicle cannot be left unattended, locked up, and idling.

I would advise pet owners use caution and always look out for your pet's well-being and safety.
